An Update from MLC Church Council

Council news

The MLC council met on March 18, 2024. A team is working on the facilities use policy/fees for those who may want to hold an event in one of our two buildings. Creating a crisis management policy was discussed. Pastor Gary will talk with Pastor Lingenfelter and Vicar Katie about MLC partnering with United in Christ and Christ Lutheran to have a representative from each congregation work on creating a policy to present to each congregational council. A media policy was adopted by the council in which the pastor or council president are the ones authorized to speak to the media.

The Moving Forward Campaign will continue until we receive the final bill for the boiler installation at 100 Mahoning St. and MLC begins to participate in Camp Mt. Luther's Foundations for the Future Campaign. Once MLC's congregation campaign leader has been trained MLC's council will set a date to begin conducting a 5-6 week campaign within our congregation. At that time, you will receive more information about the planned improvements and renovations at Camp Mt. Luther and have the opportunity to make a monetary gift or a pledge over the course of 3 years. MLC's council voted to match the individual member contributions up to \$10,000 per year of the 3-year campaign, upon review of the contribution receipts for the prior year.

More volunteers are needed to help with driving members from MDS to and from worship services each week. Currently we only have 4 volunteers to help with this. If you can help with this ministry, please contact CarolAnn in the church office.

As a reminder, the council requests that if you have any concerns or questions related to the congregational council, please talk directly with a council member. If a concern is with a ministry team, please talk with the appropriate ministry team chair. If your concern is with a staff member or the pastor, please talk directly with the pastor. Communication is key to a safe healthy church environment. Dealing with any issues or concerns as they arise is best so it can be clarified or resolved in real time allowing one to move forward. If needed, please refer to the handling complaints and conflict policy for further information.

Hiking Group

On Tuesday, 3/26/24 the church's hiking group had a 6.5 mile hike on a section of the Applanation Trail known as the Blue Mountain Loop near Palmerton, PA. This was a more difficult hike with a 1,123 mile climb up the mountain to get started, but then the hikers were rewarded with a beautiful, and nearly flat hike along the ridge of Blue Mountain, that goes over the top of the Leigh Turnpike Tunnel. After the hike the group stopped at P.J. Whelihan's for a late lunch on the way home.

The next hike will be on Saturday, 4/6/24 to Sand Run Falls. We will be traveling to Arnot, PA for a "moderate" 6.7 mile hike that only has an overall elevation gain of 682' to Sand Run Falls. The trailhead parking is just off of Arnot Road, just north of Arnot, PA. If you want to join the hike, and we would love to have you join us, meet at the church parking lot at 9 am to car-pool to the trailhead, or you can meet us at the trailhead parking lot about 10 am. We will stop for refreshments on the way home. If you prefer not to stop for refreshments you can drive separately and just follow us.

Dress for the weather, use a bug spray that repels ticks, take a day pack with water, and trekking poles if you use them.

If you would like to join us, please email or call Jeff Coup, no later than the evening before and let him know you (and anyone else you want to invite) will be attending and if you will meet at the church at 9 am or the trailhead parking lot about 10 am.




Listen God is Calling






Free hygiene / self-care products for anyone that needs them.

We are looking for people to help who are willing to cut, sew, and generally lend a hand to our creating of these quilts.


We are gathering on Wednesday April 3rd from 1pm until 3pm.



If you have any question, you can talk to an Outreach Team Member.






Saturday: 4/6/24: Meet at the church parking lot at 9 am.
