Always allow the holy spirit to lift you up and fill you with joy with this gift every single day.


Council news

The church hiking group had a very active month! On July 7th we had 8 hikers do the loop at Chimney Rock near Weikert. On July 13th just 3 of us traveled to the 1,000 Steps/Standing Stone trail near Mt Union, PA. On July 24th we had 8 hikers do the Vista Loop trail at Halfway Dam.

The next hike, on Saturday, August 10th we will be doing what is considered the best day hike in PA, the 9.3 mile long Golden Eagle Trail in the beautiful Pine Creek Valley. The hike has a challenging 2,343' of elevation and we will enjoy several great vistas including the spectacular view from Raven's Horn (see picture). 
Fidget Quilt is an event where we will gather to make small, lap quilts with fidgeting items on them for people who have Alzheimer's to keep their hands busy.

The Outreach Team is proud to announce the debut of the Happy Tails program starting here at Milton Lutheran Church. Happy Tails is a supplemental pet food program for families in need who own dogs and cats in our area. While hosting Self-Care Sanctuary over the past 21 months, many of our patrons have expressed a need for support to care for their animals as well.

We have partnered with a local resource that receives various donations of pet food and products in Columbia, Montour and Northumberland counties and is offered at largely discounted rates.

This ministry will occur alongside our Self- Care Sanctuary that happens on the first Sunday of the month from 11:30 am-12:30 pm. We have been offered the opportunity to pilot this pantry at no cost to us due to an anonymous donor providing us with means to run for at least a six-month trial basis. We plan to host our first event on Sunday, August 4<sup>th</sup>.
