### An Update from MLC Church Council

Council news

The MLC council met on Wednesday June 26, 2024. We discussed "Why Mergers Fail" from the book Better Together.

We now have three consultant options to help guide us through the discernment process: Keith Johnson, The Board Coach; the Unstuck Group; and Lead. The council will conduct interviews in July with the goal of selecting a consultant during the July 22<sup>nd</sup> council meeting. It is anticipated the recommendation of a consultant will be presented to the congregation during a special congregational meeting in August on a date to be determined.

It is anticipated the children and youth program for ages pre-K-6<sup>th</sup> grade for youth from MLC, United in Christ, and Christ in Lewisburg, will begin on September 8, 2024, and will run monthly on the second Sunday of each month from 4-6 PM. An adult group for the parents will run at the same time. The program will rotate between the three churches allowing each church to host. More details will follow in the upcoming months.

We continue to work on ways to expand the volunteer pool to help with driving our members from MDS to and from worship services and church events.

The council is in the process of contacting people to serve on the audit team.

Air Management is still waiting on a part to finish the boiler replacement at 100 Mahoning Street. When the work is completed, that invoice will be paid. That expense was approved by the congregation in 2023.

The Milton Lutheran Church hiking group had a nice hike to Dutchman Run Falls on Sunday, June 9<sup>th</sup>. From the parking lot to the falls is 1.5 miles and it is a totally unmarked trail, and at some points, no trail at all. But the sight of the falls is worth the hike! After we finished the hike we took a 4 mile drive up the very poor road to the Band Rock Vista. The road got so bad that we had to park and hike about ¾ mile to get to the vista, but once again the view was worth the effort. It has a great view of the town of Ralston and the Lycoming Creek Valley. After the vista we drove to the Crippled Bear Restaurant on Lycoming Creek Road for some good food and refreshments.

A new hiking schedule will be released soon, but the next hike will be on Sunday, July 7<sup>th</sup> to Chimney Rocks near Weikert, PA. We will meet at the church parking lot at noon (1125 Mahoning St, Milton) and car-pool 45 minutes to the trail. 
Sunday: 7/7/24: Meet at the church parking lot at noon.
