Dear Friends of the Milton Lutheran Parish,

I hope you are all doing well! I have a few updates for you this week as we begin our Lenten journey. The first day of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 17 and runs through Holy Saturday on April 3. Below is a bunch of information on how we will stay connected with God and one another during this holy season.

**Worship and Devotional Kits**- This year we will be providing worship and devotional kits for everyone to use during Lent. There will be two different kits. The first will help take us from Ash Wednesday through Palm Sunday. The second will be for Holy Week and Easter starting with Palm Sunday and will include supplies for Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday.

**Pick up Dates:** (You can come to the parish on the following dates and pick up your kits.) 1st Kit- Sunday, February 14, at 11:00 A.M. or Wednesday, February 17, between 7:30 A.M.- 1:00 P.M. 2nd Kit- Sunday, March 21, between 8:30 A.M.- 11:30 A.M. If you are a shut-in, we will have someone drop off the kit to you in your place of residence.

#### Spread the Love Worship

On Sunday, February 14, (Valentine's Day) we will have a special worship service in preparation for Lent. This service will be in addition to our live streamed service that happens each week at 9:30 A.M. You are invited to join us for worship in the parking lot of Christ at 11:00 A.M. During this service, we will a have special time of prayer, music, and story sharing. We are looking for people that would be willing to share a short story of how they have experienced God's love in the past year, either by receiving God's love or sharing it with someone else. We will also hand out our first Worship and Devotional Kits.

#### Ash Wednesday

On Wednesday, February 17, we will be recognizing Ash Wednesday in two different ways. From 7:30 A.M.- 1:00 P.M. we will have Ashes to Go. You can come to the parking lot of Christ and receive a prayer and your ashes while remaining in your vehicle. Then at 7:00 P.M. our Ash Wednesday service will be live streamed from Trinity. You will receive a container of ashes in your worship and devotional kit that you can use to participate in the service online. We are also partnering with the Breaking Bread Company to provide free chicken corn soup and bread! From 11:00 A.M.-1:00 P.M. you can stop by the parking lot at Christ to receive your ashes AND some soup and bread.

Finally, I wanted to let you know that we will resume in-person worship inside the sanctuary of Trinity starting at 9:30 A.M. on February 21st. The service will continue to be live streamed for all those who do not feel comfortable coming in person. All the same safety measures will be in place as before including a mask requirement, social distancing, and limited physical contact. There is an instructional video available on our Parish YouTube Channel that you can watch with more information about the safety measures that are in place.

#### First Reading: 2 Kings 2: 1-12

A reading from 2 Kings Chapter 2.

<sup>1</sup>Now when the Lord was about to take Elijah up to heaven by a whirlwind, Elijah and Elisha were on their way from Gilgal. <sup>2</sup>Elijah said to Elisha, "Stay here; for the Lord has sent me as far as Bethel." But Elisha said, "As the Lord lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So they went down to Bethel. <sup>3</sup>The company of prophets who were in Bethel came out to Elisha, and said to him, "Do you know that today the Lord will take your master away from you?" And he said, "Yes, I know; keep silent."

<sup>4</sup>Elijah said to him, "Elisha, stay here; for the Lord has sent me to Jericho." But he said, "As the Lord lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So they came to Jericho. <sup>5</sup>The company of prophets who were at Jericho drew near to Elisha, and said to him, "Do you know that today the Lord will take your master away from you?" And he answered, "Yes, I know; be silent."

<sup>6</sup>Then Elijah said to him, "Stay here; for the Lord has sent me to the Jordan." But he said, "As the Lord lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So the two of them went on. <sup>7</sup>Fifty men of the company of prophets also went, and stood at some distance from them, as they both were standing by the Jordan. <sup>8</sup>Then Elijah took his mantle and rolled it up, and struck the water; the water was parted to the one side and to the other, until the two of them crossed on dry ground.

<sup>9</sup>When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me what I may do for you, before I am taken from you." Elisha said, "Please let me inherit a double share of your spirit." <sup>10</sup>He responded, "You have asked a hard thing; yet, if you see me as I am being taken from you, it will be granted you; if not, it will not." <sup>11</sup>As they continued walking and talking, a chariot of fire and horses of fire separated the two of them, and Elijah ascended in a whirlwind into heaven. <sup>12</sup>Elisha kept watching and crying out, "Father, father! The chariots of Israel and its horsemen!" But when he could no longer see him, he grasped his own clothes and tore them in two pieces.
