A Letter from the Pastor

Living the Blessing After Christmas

The lights have come down, the decorations are packed away, and the familiar rhythms of daily life are settling back in. Christmas, it seems, has passed. Yet Scripture reminds us that the heart of Christmas does not belong to one day or even one season—it belongs to a promise that continues to shape our lives.

In Ephesians 1:3–14, the apostle Paul proclaims that in Christ we have already received “*every spiritual blessing*.” That message speaks powerfully in January, when the celebrations are over and we are left to live out what we have received. The child born in Bethlehem did not arrive for a momentary celebration, but to claim us, redeem us, and hold us in grace long after the carols fade.

Paul tells us that in Christ we are chosen and adopted, forgiven and sealed with the Holy Spirit. These words remind us that Christmas was not simply an event we observed—it was God’s decisive act on our behalf. The gift of Jesus does not expire when the calendar turns. It continues to define who we are and how we live.

January often invites reflection. We take stock of where we have been and wonder what lies ahead. In the midst of that uncertainty, Ephesians offers a steady foundation: our lives are rooted in God’s grace, not our resolutions or accomplishments. We move into the new year not empty-handed, but richly blessed, already claimed as God’s beloved children.

The Spirit, Paul says, is God’s seal upon us—a promise that God is not finished yet. The same God who came to us in Christ continues to work in us, drawing us toward hope, healing, and purpose. Christmas has happened, but its promise is still unfolding.

As we step into this new year, may we live with the quiet confidence that Christmas did not end—it continues in us. Rooted in grace, sustained by hope, and held in love, we move forward “*to the praise of God’s glory*.”
