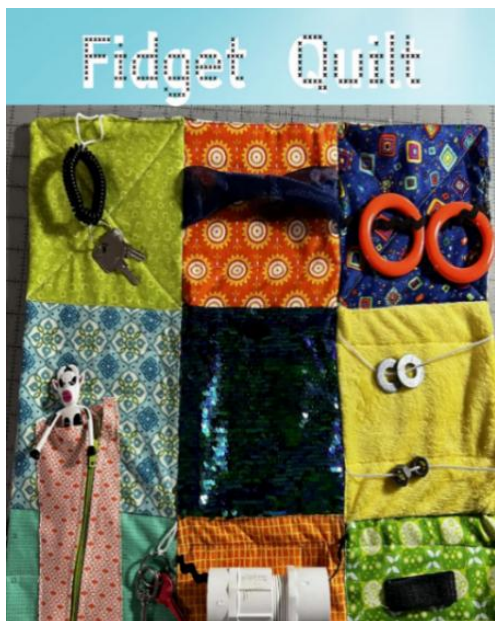
Our capital campaign is still going strong for Camp Mount Luther!

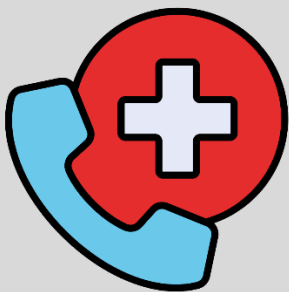

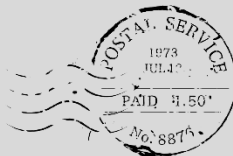
