Council news

The council met on November 18, 2024. MLC's council reviewed and approved the agreement for rental of MLC's facilities. The contact person is Chuck Stahl if anyone wishes to rent any of the facilities at either of MLC's buildings.

The previous rental agreement for the Hispanic Free Methodist Church to worship in our sanctuary and for use of the fellowship hall for special occasions was updated and approved. They plan to begin worshipping at 1125 Mahoning Street on Sunday December 8, 2024, at 11AM.

The annual council and staff Christmas dinner will be held on December 16, 2024, at the home of Lynnette Weisner.

Where are We in the Strategic Planning Process?

The Strategic Planning Team held an open meeting on Sunday, November 3rd at 8:30am. The meeting was held to address any lingering questions concerning the strategic planning process. Our consultant, Keith Johnson, was in attendance via Zoom and he spoke to the group explaining the function of strategic planning, the teams involved in the process, and how strategic planning helps to define our mission as a church family.

A training session was also held on Nov. 3rd at 1:00pm for the Strategic Planning Team. Consultant, Keith Johnson conducted the training via Zoom. Keith outlined the responsibilities and tasks of the SP Team and the key components involved in strategic planning. The team will assist in conducting a SWOTT analysis of our congregation (i.e. Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats and Trends). Information from the SWOTT analysis will be used in conjunction with feedback from the Community Assessment Team and the Facilities Utilization

Team to help us establish a new vision for MLC. We plan on encouraging people to participate in the SWOTT analysis in the following ways:

- 1. The various ministry teams will be asked to complete a SWOTT worksheet at their monthly meetings. Pastor Gary will meet with the ministry team leaders to help with this process.
- 2. Also, we are asking all congregation members to be an active part of this process. We are planning to hold Conversation Church on a Sunday morning. (date to be announced) where everyone will have an opportunity to respond to the SWOTT analysis.

The community assessment team met on Nov. 3rd at 3:00 P.M. with Keith to review the community assessment process. Carol Yost, Linwood Hill, and Karen Fry are serving on this team and they identified over a dozen people/organizations to interview. Carol Yost volunteered to lead this team. We encourage people to participate in the community assessment process in the following ways:



Hiking Group

On Saturday November 2nd the Milton Lutheran Church Hiking Group did a pilgrimage hike to the Bob and Dotty Webber homestead and graves. Bob Webber was a District Forester in the Pine Creek area and was responsible for laying-out and maintaining many of the hiking trails in that area.

The hike started just off Rt 44 south of the village of Black Forest and goes for 2.75 miles east to the ridge above Slate Run, PA. It is a great hike, made more special because two of our hikers that day were personal friends of the Webbers. Lori Bair and her husband lived for 5 years in a log cabin near the end of the Webbers lane, and Sue Wright was a Hiking friend of Bob's and even stayed at the Webbers cabin with him and Dotty. All the buildings have been torn down and the cabin moved to the PA Lumberman's Museum, but you can see most of the stone foundation of the cabin, the flagstone of the front porch and the beautiful vistas that the Webbers loved so much. Three pictures are attached.

Our next hike, and the last one until hunting season is over, will be on Black Friday, November 29th. We will meet at the church parking lot at 9am and travel to the Swift Run, Kerb Gap & Thick Mountain Trail in the Snyder-Middleswarth Natural Area. This 4.4 moderate difficulty hike is often referred to as "Tall Timbers". A map of the hike is attached. According to the DCNR, as of 2007 Snyder-Middleswarth Natural Area is 500 acres, of which 250 acres is virgin forest. The tallest trees at Snyder-Middleswarth are more than 150 feet tall and measure more than 40 inches diameter at breast height. As measured by its growth rings, one fallen tree was found to be 347 years old.

Bring a daypack with water, snacks or a sandwich, trekking poles if you use them and tick repellent. If you don't want to meet us at the church at 9 am, you can meet us at the parking lot of brick, Grace Church, on Rt 235 just as you are entering Troxelville. We should be there about 9:40 am and you can follow us the rest of the

way. After this hike I have to head home, but if the others want to stop for food and drink I can drive separately. If you will be joining us, please let me know before 6 pm the day before (Thanksgiving).






Sign-ups to help in cooking and prepping the meals for the Milton Towers are in the binder.


