Camp is a respite for so many. A place that spreads love and joy and the Word of God! Your donation will help improve Camp to be the best it can be for all who attend!

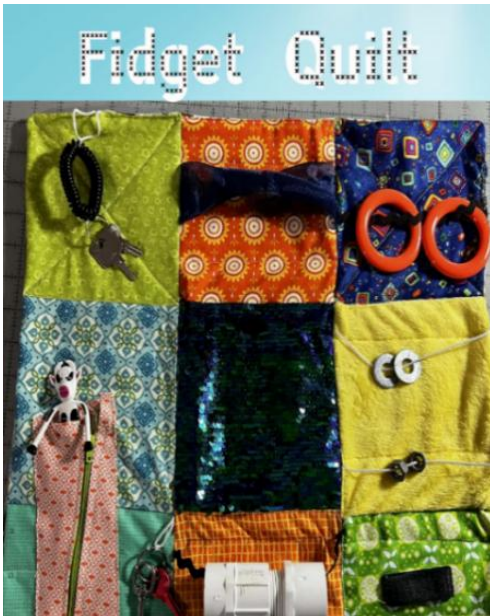

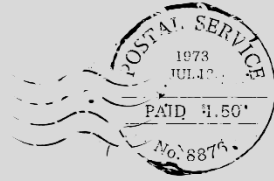

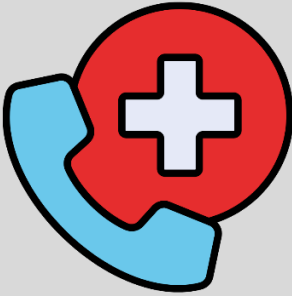
Pub Theology will be meeting on at the Turbotville Public House on July 9th at 7pm! We hope you join us for this opportunity for fellowship!!

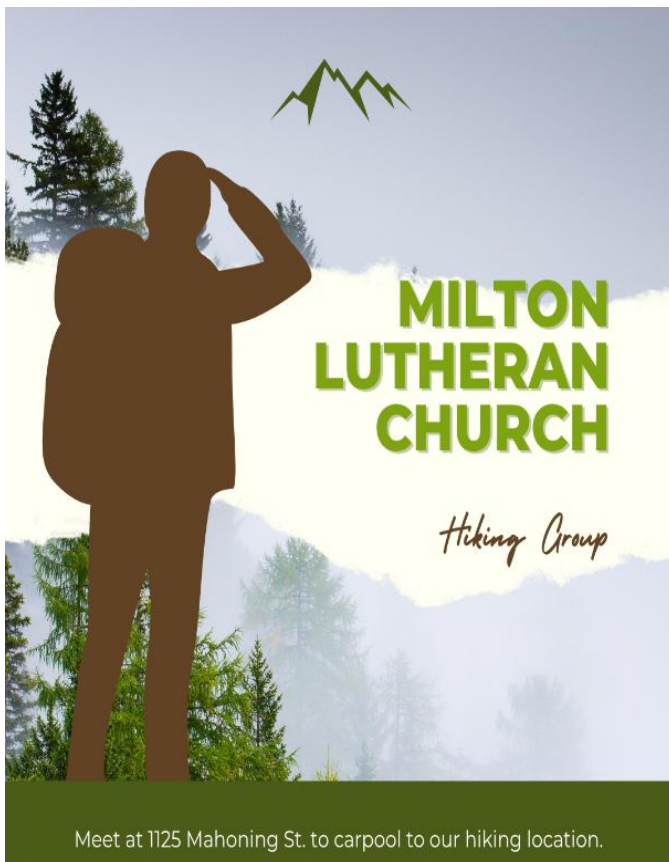

Nazareth Area High School

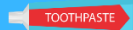
Katie is planning on attending The University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee where she will major in Business and be a member of their Equestrain Team.
