- The Fall
  - Genesis 3:22-23

#### Old Testament Precedent for Divine Health

- God promises His children healing under the Old Covenant
  - Exodus 15:26
  - Hebrews 13:8
  - Exodus 23:25
  - o Psalm 105:37

#### The New Testament Fulfillment of God's Healing

- Jesus has redeemed us from the curse of the Law
  - o Galatians 3:13-14
  - Deuteronomy 28:58-61
  - Deuteronomy 7:15
- We are now heirs to the promises of Abraham
  - o Romans 4:13
  - o Galatians 4:7
  - 1 Corinthians 15:21-22
- The Cross: Healing & salvation happened on the same day
  - Isaiah 53:4-5
  - o 1 Peter 2:24
  - Hebrews 9:28
  - o Matthew 8:16-17

#### Are the Days of Miracles Past?

- Spiritual gifts
  - o 1 Corinthians 12:4-11
- Are the days of salvation past?
  - o Romans 13:8
- Come & see: The power of testimonies
  - Revelation 12:11
- If healing was part of our inheritance under the Old Covenant, how much more under the New Covenant?

What Do We Have Authority Over?

- Sickness and disease
  - o Mark 16:15-18
- All the power of the enemy. *All* means *all*!
  - o Luke 10:19
  - o James 4:7
- Anything of this world
  - o 1 John 4:4
  - Ephesians 1:11-14

#### Who Has This Authority?

- Divine transference of authority:
  - 1) Jesus has all authority
    - Mathew 28:18-20
  - 2) Jesus passed on His authority to the twelve discipleso Luke 9:1-2
  - Jesus gave His authority to another seventy disciples
     Luke 10:1-2, 9
  - 4) Jesus gave His authority to all believerso Mark 16:15-18
- Authority comes with **power** 
  - Luke 24:49
  - Acts 1:4-5, 8
- Apostles who heal in the Book of Acts
  - Peter & John: Acts 3:1-8
  - Stephen: Acts 6:1-8
  - Philip: Acts 8:5-7
  - Paul: Acts 14:8-10, 19:11-12

#### Why Do We Have This Authority?

- We have an Intercessor in Heaven
  - o 1 Timothy 2:5
  - o Romans 8:34
- We can use His name: the power of the name Jesus
  - o John 14:12-14
  - Acts 3:16
  - Philippians 2:9-11



o Matthew 18:18-19

#### Defining Heaven's Authority

- Jesus' authority lasts forever
  - Hebrews 13:8
  - Matthew 28:18-20
- His authority is unconditional
  - o Psalm 138:2

#### Our Divine Position as God's People

- Jesus is the Head; We are the body
  - Colossians 1:18
  - Matthew 10:8
- Jesus has given all of us a unique role to play
  - o 1 Corinthians 12:11-13
- We are His hands and feet: if we don't do it, nobody will
  - Ephesians 1:19-23
- As we freely give, we receive more
  - o Matthew 10:8
  - o John 7:37-39
- The same Spirit who lives in Jesus lives in you!
  - o Romans 8:11

Faith as Part of the Healing Process

- The Great Hall of Faith: Hebrews 11

- We are out to replicate a process that was:
  - 1) Demonstrated by God
  - 2) Adopted by our ancestors
  - 3) Made perfect in Jesus

#### Characteristics of Faith

- 1) Faith is a position
- 2) Faith is different from hope
  - Proverbs 13:12
- 3) Faith has no fear
  - o 1 John 4:4
  - o 1 John 5:4
- 4) Faith is not embarrassed
  - o Luke 12:9-10
  - o Psalm 118:6
  - $\circ$  1 Corinthians 2:5
- 5) Faith is bold
  - o Mark 5:28-34
- 6) Faith is creative
  - o Romans 1:17
- 7) Faith is restorative
  - o 2 Corinthians 5:17
- 8) Faith is the key ingredient to righteous living
  - o Romans 4:13
- 9) Faith is the key to our sanctification
  - Acts 26:18
- 10) Faith is all that is required for salvation
  - o Romans 3:28
  - o Romans 10:9
- 11) Faith was and is completely and perfectly demonstrated by Jesus
  - o Hebrews 12:2



- 12) Faith is a relationship with God built on trust
  - o Hebrews 10:38
- 13) Faith can be counter-intuitive
- 14) Faith is not seen
  - 2 Corinthians 5:7
- 15) Faith can be a gift!
  - o 1 Corinthians 12:8-10
  - o Romans 8:11

- 16) Faith is all or nothing

## Part V: Roadblocks to Healing

#### **Unforgiveness**

٠

- How inability to forgive affects our relationship with God
  - Mark 11:25-26
  - Matthew 5:23-24
  - How unforgiveness affects our relationship with others o 1 Corinthians 6:16
- Forgiveness should be specific

#### Lack of Knowledge

- Ignorance is *bliss*; but ignorance does not make you *blessed* 
  - o Isaiah 5:13
  - Proverbs 29:18
- Wisdom is the proper application of knowledge
  - o Psalm 111:10
  - Proverbs 3:13

#### Personal & Family Sins

- Your own sins can interfere with your relationship with God

   Isaiah 59:2
- Generational sins can interfere with your relationship with God
  - Deuteronomy 5:9

#### Lack of Faith

•

- Without faith, we cannot please God
  - Hebrews 11:6
  - We must ask in faith if we intend to receive healing • James 1:6-8
- We must have faith *before* we see the manifestation
  - Hebrews 11:1

#### Pursuing Signs and Wonders

- Signs and wonders should *follow* us
  - o Mark 16:17
- Our primary goal is to uphold the word of God
  - Acts 14:3
- Not every sign and wonder is from God
  - o 2 Thessalonians 2:9
- The difference between healing and miracles
  - o 1 Corinthians 12:9-10



Expecting God to Heal on Our Terms

- Think outside the box
- God is interested in <u>restoration</u> more than the <u>quick fix</u>
- Yahweh is better than your way

#### Looking to Man Instead of God

• Trust in God for healing; not man

#### Not Properly Discerning the Lord's Body

- What does it mean to take communion "in an unworthy manner"
  - o 1 Corinthians 11:27-30
  - Hebrews 10:29
- Communion is for our <u>benefit</u>

#### Bridle the Tongue

- The tongue is <u>powerful</u>
  - Proverbs 18:21
  - o Mark 11:23
- Agreement binds the enemy
  - o Matthew 18:18-19
- Our mouths should be conduits for God's word
  - Hebrews 4:12

#### Doing the Right Things

• Exercising and eating right

#### Being Problem-Centered

- Being God-centered
- Growing up
  - Hebrews 5:12
- Understand your position

#### Cessationism: Thinking Healing was Only for the Early Church

- If the devil can still make us sick, God can still make us well
- Remembering the progression of divine authority

#### Is Healing for Everyone?

- Is salvation for everyone?
- <u>All means all</u>
  - o Matthew 4:23
  - Luke 4:40



#### Being Sick for God's Glory

- Whom are you glorifying? • John 3:14
- <u>A More Excellent Way</u> by Henry W. Wright

### Thinking Sickness Teaches You Something

Where does the Bible say faith comes by sickness?
 o Romans 10:17

### I'll Be Healed "If" It's God's Will

- God's word is His will
  - Mark 1:41
- Healing and salvation happened on the same day
   1 Thessalonians 5:23
  - What to do with Job
    - Job 1:6-12

٠

- Paul's thorn in the flesh
  - 2 Corinthians 12:7
- Where does grace come in?






## Part VI: How to Keep Your Healing

Recognize the Enemy's Role in the Process

- Sickness is the result of oppression from the devil (with obvious exceptions)
   Acts 10:38
  - Good soil and bad soil

٠

•

- Matthew 13:3-9
- Four types of seed
- Four types of seed
  - 1) Seed on <u>hard</u> ground
    - Matthew 13:19
  - 2) Seed on stony ground
    - Matthew 13:20-21
    - Luke 11:24-26
  - 3) Seed on <u>thorny</u> ground
    - Matthew 13:22
    - Mark 9:43
  - 4) Seed on good ground
    - Matthew 13:23
- Prevention is key
- Recurring symptoms are worthless idols; do not honor them
   Jonah 2:8

### Position vs. Condition

Your healing is guaranteed by the word of God

 Psalm 138:2

### Belief vs. Unbelief

- Unbelief cancels the miraculous
  - o Mark 6:5-6
- If we have faith, <u>anything</u> is possible
  - o Mark 9:23-26
- "If it is Your will" is a prayer killer
  - o Mark 1:40-42
  - Luke 15:20
- <u>Faith</u> is not <u>denial</u>
  - Romans 4:19-22
  - o 1 Samuel 17:26



Dealing with Common Questions

- Will going to the doctor cancel my healing?
- Will taking medicine cancel my healing?
  - o 2 Kings 20:7
  - Luke 10:34

#### Faith versus Fear

- <u>Faith</u> activates the good news; <u>fear</u> cultivates the bad news
  - o 1 John 4:4
- Focus on the symptoms generates fear
  - o Isaiah 26:3
  - o James 4:7






## Part VII: The Anointing

What is the Anointing?

- Dictionary definition:
  - To rub or sprinkle on; apply an ointment or oily liquid
  - To smear with any liquid
  - To consecrate or make sacred in a ceremony that includes the application of oil
     i.e. He anointed the new High Priest
  - To dedicate to the service of God
- Ministry definition:
  - The manifest presence of God's Holy Spirit.
  - God's <u>power</u> within us to activate God's <u>purpose</u> in our lives.
  - Luke 4:18-19
  - The anointing brings revelation of God's love to those who need it.
- Christ literally means 'Anointed One'
  - Acts 10:38

What Does the Anointing Do?

- The anointing exists so we can accomplish God's purposes
  - The anointing is <u>productive</u>. It <u>produces</u>.
  - o Acts 10:38 (above)
- The anointing is given to heal and restore
- The anointing activates God's word and makes us creative
  - o 1 John 2:27
  - o 1 John 2:20
  - The anointing brings wisdom
    - o John 14:26

•

- The anointing strengthens
  - Philippians 4:13
- The anointing gives <u>freedom</u> and <u>destroys every yoke</u>
  - o Isaiah 10:27

#### How Do We Invite and Dwell In the Anointing?

- Be <u>inter</u>dependent instead of <u>in</u>dependent. Stay humble; rely on God and others.
  - 1 Peter 5:5-6
- The <u>word</u> and the <u>anointing</u> go hand in hand
  - Hebrews 5:12-14
  - Ephesians 3:20
  - John 14:12
- We must <u>ask</u> for the anointing
  - o 2 Kings 4:1-7
  - o Isaiah 55:1



- Be <u>desperate</u> for His presence and He will meet you where you are.
- The way to overcome the <u>enemy</u> is to be overcome by  $\underline{God}$ .
- Prayer and fasting
  - o Mark 9:29

## Fruit of the Spirit

- They will know us by our <u>fruit</u>
  - Galatians 5:22-23
- <u>Fruit</u> of the Spirit powers the <u>gifts</u> of the Spirit
  - o 1 Corinthians 12






## **Part VIII: Intercession**

#### What Is Intercession?

- Prayer in favor of another
  - Prayer is humbly making a request to God with adoration, confession, supplication and thanksgiving.
- Interceding on behalf of others by standing in the gap

#### Can Anyone Be An Intercessor?

- God calls <u>all</u> Christians to intercede
- Intercessors must be spiritually <u>healthy</u>
- Where do you fit in the Healing Rooms?

#### Why Do We Need an Intercessory Team?

- Jesus was a Man of prayer. We must learn to be like Him.
  - o Mark 1:35
  - Luke 6:12
  - Luke 5:16
- We must pray so we can cooperate with the Father and do His work
  - o 1 Thessalonians 5:17
- <u>Healing</u> the sick requires <u>prayer</u>
  - o James 5:14-16
- Jesus intercedes for us, and we intercede for others
  - Hebrews 7:25
  - Isaiah 53:12
- Intercession is not a <u>competition</u>
  - Matthew 6:7
- To intercede for another person means to give thanks for them
  - o 1 Timothy 2:1
  - Ephesians 6:18
- When we intercede, God shows <u>mercy</u>
  - o Daniel 9
  - o Daniel 10:12
  - Acts 12:5

#### What Gives Us Authority to Pray for Others?

- We are no longer praying as a <u>widow;</u> we are praying as a <u>bride</u>
- Authority is activated when you know who you are in Christ



- John 1:12
- Hebrews 4:16
- We were created for <u>relationship</u> with God
- The same Holy Spirit who intercedes in Jesus intercedes in us!
  - o Romans 8:11
- God calls us to heal the sick; not just to pray for them
  - o Matthew 10:8
- All authority means all power
  - o Matthew 28:18
- We are positioned <u>in Jesus</u>
  - Ephesians 2:5,6
  - Ephesians 1:19

### What Do We Need to Intercede?

- The armor of God
  - Ephesians 6:10-20
- Intercession is spiritual warfare

### Why Don't We Always See Our Prayers Answered?

- Unforgiveness
- Asking amiss
- Failure to persevere
- Other roadblocks from the "Roadblocks to Healing" section of this course

### How Can I Intercede Well?

- The importance of <u>intimacy</u>
  - o Psalm 27:4
  - Exodus 33:15

### How Intercession Works in the Healing Rooms

- Main intercessor prays over the intercessory team
- The team of intercessors prays over the client's sheet after intake
  - Be specific! God rewards <u>specific</u> requests.
- If you are a believer, you are called to be prophetic
- Prayer and intercession is a <u>dialogue</u>; not a <u>monologue</u>
  - o John 10:27
- Leave your opinions at home.
- **<u>Pray it; don't say it!!</u>**

## Part IX: Deliverance

Why Deliverance?

- You <u>will</u> encounter clients in the Healing Rooms who need deliverance
- Deliverance and healing often go hand in hand

#### Examples of Deliverance in the Bible

- Matthew 8:16-17
- Mark 1:32-34
- Luke 4:40-41

### 10-Step Deliverance Model by Pablo Bottari

- 1) Give the Individual Priority
  - Luke 10:17-20
  - Philippians 2:9-11
- 2) If the spirit is manifesting (or if one manifests during your ministry), make the spirit be quiet and submit to you in the Name of Jesus
- 3) Establish and maintain communication with the person receiving prayer
- 4) Ask the person receiving prayer what they want to be free from and try to make sure they actually want to get free
  - Matthew 12:43-45
- 5) Make sure the person receiving prayer has accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior
- 6) Interview the person receiving ministry to discover the events, relationships, or situations which have led to the bondage
  - Ephesians 4:26-27
- 7) Lead the person receiving prayer in closing these doors and removing these footholds
  Mark 13:11
- 8) Cast out the unclean spirits in the Name of Jesus
  - Matthew 8:16
- 9) Join the person receiving prayer in praise and thanks to the Lord Jesus for the deliverance
  - 1 John 4:1-3
- 10) Ask the person to pray for the Holy Spirit's infilling and to fill all the places formerly occupied by the evil spirits

### Some Words of Caution

- This is only a <u>model</u>; the real key to deliverance is the <u>authority</u> that comes from <u>intimacy</u>
- Believers should never be demon-focused
  - o Romans 8:37-39



- Don't face the <u>enemy</u>; face <u>God</u>
  - We drive out darkness by <u>introducing light;</u> not by cursing the darkness.

#### Addressing Your Concerns

- Where does the demon go when it comes out of the client? Am I at risk?
   Acts 19:13-16
- What if the demon doesn't come out?
  - o Matthew 17:14-21
- Can a Christian be <u>possessed</u> by a demon?
  - Possession versus oppression

#### Dealing With Demonic Oppression in the Healing Rooms

- Two types of people who won't want to be set free:
  - 1) Those who are <u>demon-focused</u>
  - 2) Those who use oppression as a cover for a <u>heart issue</u>
- Using the gift of discernment wisely
- We are not here to point out the <u>dirt</u>. We are here to dig for <u>gold</u> in the dirt.
- Simple keys for deliverance from oppression
  - o Colossians 2:15
