

MINISTERIAL FRAUD UPON THE COURT

The City represents that in response to the Attorney General's opinion, the City has directed Jordan to cease all law enforcement duties until there has been a final resolution.

On November 7, 2003, the City adopted Ordinance No. 2667, revising and amending Ordinance No. 2616. The new Ordinance designated the City Manager as the appropriate authority for the Police Department and designated the Police Director as the executive officer of the Police Department. In addition to the broad administrative duties assigned to the Police Director in Ordinance No. 2616, the new Ordinance authorized the Police Director to:

1. Administer and enforce all ordinances of the City and the laws of the State of New Jersey, and such rules and regulations as may be promulgated for the regulation of the police department
2. Have, exercise and discharge the functions, powers and duties of the Police Department; and
