I am providing this media free-of-charge.

Contained within this ZIP archive are two embroidery patterns made/intended for the Brother series of computerized embroidery machines:

- DRC Mini Patch: This is a 4 x 4 inch patch with two colors, Prussian Blue for the border, and White for the logo itself. You will need to use fray-prevention adhesive (such as Fray-Check) before you cut the patch out.

- DRC Back Patch: This is a 6.5 x 6.5 inch patch, without a border, intended to be sewn on a square of fabric, which is then sewn on the back of a clothing item. The pattern contains only one color, White, for the logo itself. This file contains a large amount of stitches, so my suggestion is to sew it in two steps:

- Wind your machine's **lower** bobbin to its maximum capacity (as much thread as it will comfortably take without jamming the machine), sew the text and the logo, but **stop** after your machine completes the large fill area of the logo's delta-shape, but before it continues with the delta's border. (The needle should correctly be at the lower-right portion of the delta when it completes the fill.)
- Remove the embroidery frame, cut the excess thread from the machine, unwind and save the remaining **lower** bobbin thread for another project (by winding it onto an empty spool), use a full-capacity fresh winding of new thread on your **lower** bobbin, then resume sewing.

If you did this right, you should be able to produce the entire logo without running out of thread in the middle of sewing.

Have fun, and I hope your logo turns out as well as mine did! ;)
