As we know COVID-19 is impacting all sectors of life; AA meetings are no exception.

Recent CDC and gubernatorial mandates require us to limit our gatherings to less than 10 people. Many of our host facilities are temporarily closing, forcing us to find new ways to carry the message.

The Treatment and Accessibilities Committee is exploring ZOOM for on-line meetings. As a committee, we discussed the value in scheduling daily ZOOM meetings during peak times. If there is interest in pursuing this option, it would require volunteers to commit to hosting a meeting at a given time slot on a consistent basis.

If there is enough interest and commitment from groups and individuals the Treatment & Accessibilities Committee will move forward with arrangements to schedule the meetings and train our hosts on the use of ZOOM.

In the interim, please be advised that Alcoholics Anonymous neither produces nor endorses a list of online, ZOOM or remote access meetings. Online meetings with public links and access codes should be joined with the understanding that there is no anonymity protection.

In an effort to protect anonymity, District 02 will rely on member to member invitations to ZOOM meetings. We are currently working on a system to disseminate information while maintaining anonymity at the public level. Please check the District 02 website for details

System limitations and increased demand on teleconferencing resources required us to select times where the largest populations can be served.
