In addition, the \$10,000 Harman Jr.-A/O Jumper Classic and the \$15,000 Seahorse Jumper Classic promise to challenge some of the West Coast's finest riders with difficult and exciting courses.

The Peninsula Committee Children's Hospital is unique in that entire families become involved in the colorful show. They provide planning, preparation and personnel to staff the event, and in the process, they give over 15,000 volunteer hours each year.
