It has two fully scheduled rings offering a wide variety of classes, including the prestigious PCHA Horsemanship Medal Finals for riders 14 and under and 18-34, as well as the PCHA Victor Hugo-Vidal Adult Horsemanship Finals for riders 35 and over. The \$10,000 Harman Family Junior A/O Jumper Classic and the \$15,000 Seahorse Open Jumper Classic also challenge some of the West Coast's finest riders.

PCCH is unique in that its membership is comprised of over 175 families who plan, implement, and staff this event, volunteering over 15,000 hours each year. Food booths, boutiques, and children's activities make it a wonderful experience for both riders and spectators.
