


PARKING ORDINANCE

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Avoca, New York held at the Town Office Building located at 3 Chase Street, Avoca, New York on the 14th day of January, 1969, and a Public Hearing having been held pursuant to a Notice duly published according to law and all persons having been duly heard, and on motion of Trustee Gerald Mattice, seconded by Trustee William Hunt, the following Parking Ordinance was enacted:

That from the 1st day of November to and including the first day of May of each calendar year, no vehicle shall be parked or shall remain parked between the hours of 1:00 a. m. and 6:30 a.m. on any public street in the Village of Avoca, New York.

Further, that any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a penalty not to exceed \$5.00 (Five) for each offense.


This Ordinance shall take effect January 30, 1969.
