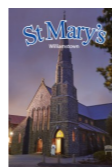

Dear Parishioners,
With regard to the "Mission side" of our Renewal Program in May, if you have not been contacted already, you will be within the next month to discuss the ministry you have volunteered for. In regards to the "Maintenance side" of our Renewal Program, also within next month, there should be progress in certain works concerning the Church. Before starting some painting within the church, especially nearer the sides doors, there are two areas that need more urgent attention. These areas are the front foyer (look for yourself there after Mass as you will see clearly) and a hidden area: the left side confessional. On that left side we have had problems for a while. There are real damp type issues within the confessional area and this has necessitated the spending of in excess of \$3,000 on plumbing issues such as the need for more down piping on that school side of Church. Also, if you are familiar with the terms 'pointing', 'repointing' and 'tuck pointing' you can understand that there are problems on that side needed to be addressed otherwise there will be water seepage of some kind or other getting from the outside walls of church to the inside. We will be working on that in the next month also and hoping to get onto some general painting sooner rather than later.



It is two years since we had our last "New Parishioners Luncheon." Sometimes we have had two of these in a year but we were stopped in our tracks last year by 'Covid.' Accordingly, if you have been a new parishioner over last two years or returned to Mass in the last two years, feel free to join us immediately after the 10:30am Mass on Sunday 25th July at the Parish Centre. Already from last weekend the following families have informed us that they are coming: Almeida, D'Souza, Darwin, Goodwin and Gherdovich. Please follow their lead and join us as myself and the members of the Parish Council would like to say hello to you. Prior warning !! – Yes next weekend there will be the annual collection for "Propagation of the Faith."
