


Dear Parishioners.



Slavery of African ancestry black people is one of the greatest sins of former generations. Thankfully Abraham Lincoln helped greatly to rid his country of slavery for black people. He was President of the United States from 1861 until his assassination in 1865. He led his country through the greatest constitutional, military and moral crisis – the American Civil War to much greater economic prosperity and the abolition of slavery. What most people would not know though is that while running for President of the United States

there was a man called Stanton, who never lost an opportunity to vilify Lincoln. Yet when Lincoln won the election, he gave Stanton a post in his cabinet. Why? Because he considered him the best man for the job, and Lincoln was proved right. Stanton gave loyal service to his nation and to Lincoln. Asked why he didn't destroy his enemies, Lincoln replied: "Do I not destroy my enemies when I make them my friends?" Stanton said also something most interesting after the assassination of Abraham Lincoln: "There lies the most perfect ruler of men the world has ever seen."!! Well, one could easily say that Lincoln could be classified as a follower of Jesus Christ in that he put into practise one of the most difficult of Jesus' exhortations from today's Gospel: "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you."

Unfortunately there is continuing tragic news from Syria and Turkey with the earthquake damage to buildings and families. As we give out the Project Compassion boxes or envelopes this weekend it should make us even more aware of the importance of our main aid agency 'Caritas Australia' as it sponsors Project Compassion in Lent. "Caritas Australia" as per usual will be directing efforts to help our "Caritas International" agencies in emergency relief.



Lent is of course an opportunity for growth in the spiritual life. Accordingly, for another means of help to your spiritual life we have managed to get another lovely booklet that covers not only the Sunday
