- IDEWM academically accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons, Glasgow.
- IDiMM accredited by UIAA/ICAR/ISMM.
- Completed part-time over 1-3 years.
- IDEWM can be completed as a stand-alone UK academic diploma in 4 modules.
  
- Covers expedition, medical, field & mountain skills in a diverse range of environments: mountains, altitude, cold, hot, wet and sub-aqua.
- Designed and written by two of the authors of the Oxford Handbook of Expedition and Wilderness Medicine. This book is used as its core text.
- Taught by experienced holders of IDEWM & IDiMM, who have field experience and “have been there and done it”.
- Consists of 4 week long residential modules for IDEWM (Glasgow, Cairngorms, Dartington, Morocco), 2 week long residential modules for IDiMM (Cairngorms, Alps), plus on-line learning modules.
- Online learning:
  - Infectious diseases, Global Health, Research, Navigation, Mountains and Cold.
  - Emporiatrics, Tropical and Maritime, Thermal Injuries, Altitude and Desert
  - Avalanche medicine, Hypothermia and Nutrition in the Mountains
  
- Upon completion, successful candidates may use their IDEWM to APEL (accreditation of prior learning) towards an MSc in Glasgow (Glasgow Caledonian University).
- Costs 2022 £1850/module inclusive of food and accommodation.
