## Required guided lab component

Module 11 includes a required guided lab component. The course instructions outline this requirement. In addition, in the course instructional materials folder, there is a separate PDF document with the lab exercises and reflective prompts provided for easy reference.

## Post-Test Completion Time = 35 minutes

Each module has a 5-question post-test to demonstrate knowledge and attainment of learning outcomes before moving to the next module. The final CE course post-test has 15 questions. The total number of post-test questions with both the module post-tests and final course post-test is 70 questions. Based on the calculation formula of 10 questions = 5 min., the total post-test completion time is 35 minutes.

Achievement of  $\geq 70\%$  is required on each module post-test before moving to the next module. Repeated attempts are permitted for the module post-tests. All participants receive a **Customized Certificate of Completion** upon successful completion of course and post-test.
