Per TCEQ regulations, the City must have at least one record of a passing test on file for each assembly installed. We respectfully request that you provide the required passing test report(s) within thirty (30) days.

If you have test records from previous tests, please forward a copy to our office. If no records exist, you will need to acquire a Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester (BPAT) to accomplish this testing. A list of approved testers is attached for your reference.
