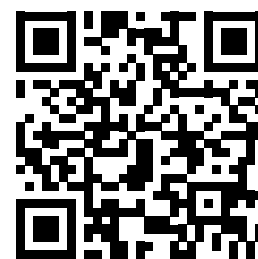

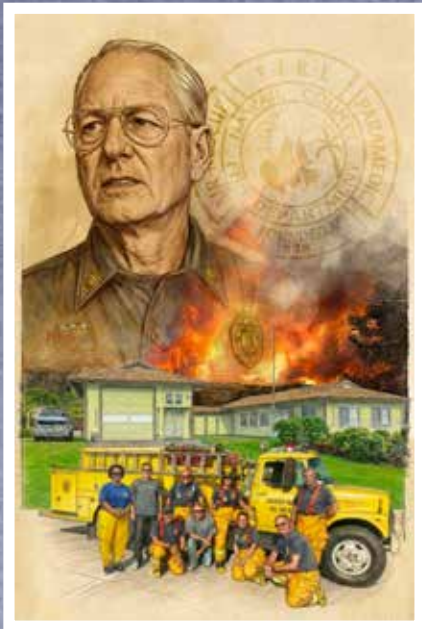

"Portraits for Patriots" is designed to honor those who dedicated themselves to their communities and their nation. The goal of this portrait program is to highlight ones service and sacrifice as a defining part of their personal story.

While it is understood that a lifetime of service can have ample memories and benchmarks, it is our goal to create a clear and honorable visual narrative in a clear and consistent compositional format.

In order to help with the selection process for this project, here are a few content submission guidelines to acheive the best results for your portrait.



1.) Choose a clear photograph of the individual to be featured in the portrait. When possible, select an image that includes their service uniform or outfit that appropriately represents their service. It does not matter if these images are in color or black and white as they will be turned into a monochromatic pencil sketch before they are added to the final composition.



2.) One of the items we recommended including in the composition is the patch, seal, or insignia of the service sector or unit you wish to highlight. This can also include medals or honors given in reference to distinguished service and or sacrifice. If you do not have imagery of one of these items, it may be possible to locate an appropriate replacement if noted in the submission form.



3.) Additional elements should include imagery of the things that defined the individuals experiance in the service of their community or the country. Things like vehicles, or tools of the trade, help to add context to the persons unique story. Special buildings or iconic landmarks are also good at making each portrait a personal memento to treasure for years to come.

Portraits For Patriots



Mission Statement

Portraits For Patriots exists solely to honor service, sacrifice, and legacy through respectful commemorative artwork. Every portrait is created with the intention of preserving dignity and celebrating honorable service. Requests that conflict with this mission may be declined.

Eligibility

Portraits For Patriots is intended to honor United States military veterans, active-duty service members, first responders, and Gold Star families. Cookhouse Studios reserves the right to request reasonable documentation verifying eligibility when necessary. Eligibility does not guarantee acceptance into the program.

Right to Refuse Service

Cookhouse Studios reserves the right at its sole discretion to refuse any commission, cancel a project prior to completion, or decline submitted materials that are inconsistent with the mission, values, or artistic standards of Portraits For Patriots.

Political and Ideological Neutrality

Portraits are intended to commemorate service and are not intended as political statements. Portraits may not be used to promote partisan political messaging, extremist organizations, hate groups, or divisive ideological causes.

Copyright

All artwork remains the copyrighted intellectual property of Scott T. Cook unless otherwise agreed in writing. Clients receive a non-exclusive personal-use license for display, printing, and sharing. Artwork may not be reproduced for commercial purposes without written permission.

Promotional Use

Unless otherwise requested in writing, Cookhouse Studios reserves the right to display completed artwork for promotional, portfolio, exhibition, website, or social media purposes.

Client Responsibilities

Clients are responsible for providing clear, accurate reference photographs and obtaining permission to submit any photographs depicting other individuals. The artist is not responsible for inaccuracies resulting from poor-quality or incomplete reference material. Clients warrant that they have permission to use and submit all photographs, logos, insignia, and other reference materials provided for the portrait.

Completion Time

Estimated completion times vary according to project demand and complexity. Completion dates are estimates only and are not guaranteed.

Revisions

One reasonable revision addressing factual inaccuracies, uniform details, insignia, or likeness concerns is included. Additional revisions, design changes, or requests outside the original scope may be denied or incur additional charges.

Terms of Agreement Cont.

- 1.) Portraits are created as original digital mixed-media illustrations based on reference materials supplied by the client. While every effort is made to achieve an accurate likeness, each portrait reflects the artist's individual style and creative interpretation rather than a photographic reproduction.
- 2.) Each portrait collage consists of four compositional parts.
 1. the main image consisting of a likeness of a first responder, veteran, active service member or Gold Star honored family member.
 2. a likeness or representation of a group affiliation logo or insignia with significant personal, professional, or service-related relevance. If multiple affiliations are requested, the artist may request to limit affiliations for compositional reasons.
 3. two additional elements that have personal or professional relevance to their individual's service. Additional elements may be added for a fee of \$50 for each addition. The artist retains final discretion regarding the number, placement, size, and presentation of all compositional elements.
- 3.) The completed portrait will be delivered to the client via digital download and/or a museum-quality print suitable for framing. The default print size is 9.5"X13" in a portrait orientation. Other sizes and formats are available for an additional charge. Shipping costs are the responsibility of the client. Cookhouse Studios is not responsible for delays or damage occurring after shipment by the carrier.
- 4.) Portraits For Patriots is not a collaborative design service. The overall artistic concept, composition, color palette, layout, and stylistic execution remain entirely at the discretion of the artist. While client preferences will be considered whenever practical, the final artistic decisions remain with the artist. Clients may make requests, but the artist is under no obligation to incorporate those requests. Clients may request to purchase isolated elements from the collage at an additional fee.
- 5.) Full payment must be received before work begins or reference materials are accepted.
- 6.) Due to the custom nature of commissioned artwork, refunds are not guaranteed. If a legitimate concern arises, the artist will make one reasonable attempt to correct the issue. Refund requests will be evaluated solely at the artist's discretion and only when made in good faith and consistent with the Terms of Agreement.
- 7.) Cookhouse Studios reserves the right to reject any submitted photographs, logos, insignia, or other materials that:
 - violate copyright or trademark laws
 - contain nudity or sexually explicit material
 - depict illegal activity
 - glorify criminal conduct
 - promote hate groups, extremist organizations, terrorism, or discriminatory content
 - depict graphic violence
 - contain offensive or defamatory material
 - are inconsistent with the mission and values of Portraits For Patriots
- 8.) Portraits For Patriots is intended to commemorate honorable service. Cookhouse Studios reserves the right to decline requests involving individuals whose actions, conduct, or circumstances, in the artist's reasonable judgment, conflict with the mission of honoring integrity, courage, sacrifice, and public service.
- 9.) Acceptance of a portrait request does not constitute an endorsement by Cookhouse Studios of any organization, agency, policy, or individual beyond the commemorative purpose of the Portraits For Patriots program.
