

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how the Committee of Rickey Dandridge for Sheriff of Hanover County (“we,” “our,” “us”) collects, uses, and shares personal information when you visit our website, sign up for updates, or contact us. This policy also covers how we use Textedly (the “Textedly service”) to send SMS/text messages on our behalf.

1. Who we are

Rickey Dandridge For Sheriff is the campaign committee for Rickey R. Dandridge for Sheriff of Hanover County, Virginia. You can reach us using the contact information in Section 13.

2. Information we collect

We may collect personal information in the following ways:

- **Information you provide directly**

- When you sign up for text messages, we collect information you submit (commonly your phone number and consent).
When you use our contact forms or submit requests, we collect information you provide (such as your name, email address, phone number, and message contents).

- **Information collected automatically**

- Website usage information (e.g., pages viewed, browser/device type, approximate location derived from IP address, and similar technical data), if our website collects it.

- **Information related to text messaging**

- Phone numbers and message delivery/interaction information (e.g., whether messages were delivered, and how you respond).

3. How we use personal information

We use personal information to:

- Send you SMS/text messages you request or for which you provide consent;
- Respond to inquiries you send to us;
- Manage and administer campaign communications and outreach;
- Maintain and secure our systems;
- Comply with applicable laws and regulations.

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4. Textedly (SMS/text messaging)

We use Textedly to send SMS/text messages as part of our outreach. Textedly may process personal information (such as phone numbers and message content/metadata necessary to deliver and manage messages) to provide the service to us.

5. When we share personal information

We do not sell personal information. We may share personal information:

- **With vendors and service providers** that help us run our campaign and communications, including **Textedly**;
- **When required by law** or to protect rights, safety, and security;
- **With your consent** or as otherwise permitted by applicable law.

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6. Cookies and similar technologies (website)

If our website uses cookies or similar technologies, we use them to help the site function, remember preferences, and understand site usage. You can control cookies through your browser settings.

7. Your choices (including SMS opt-out)

If you receive SMS/text messages from us, you can typically opt out at any time by replying **STOP** to a message or using the opt-out instructions provided in our texts. After opting out, we may continue to process your phone number only to the extent necessary to honor your request and for compliance purposes.

You may also contact us to:

- Request updates, corrections, or deletion (where applicable and required by law);
- Ask questions about this Privacy Policy.

8. Data retention

We keep personal information only as long as necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including to comply with applicable legal requirements and election-related recordkeeping obligations.

9. Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures designed to protect personal information. However, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure.

10. Children's privacy

Our campaign website and communications are not directed to children, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children.

11. International transfers

If we use service providers that process information in other countries, we will take steps designed to protect personal information in accordance with applicable law.

12. Changes to this Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. The "Last updated" date will reflect when changes were made. If changes are material, we will take steps required by applicable law.
