

Terms and Conditions

Welcome to **Rickey R. Dandridge For Sheriff** (“Campaign,” “we,” “us,” “our”). These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) govern your access to and use of our website located at <https://voterickeyrdandridgeforsheriff.vote/> (the “Site”). By using the Site, including submitting any forms or signing up for volunteer or event communications, you agree to these Terms.

1) Political Nature of the Site

This Site relates to Rickey R. Dandridge’s campaign for Sheriff of Hanover County, Virginia (“Office/Campaign”). Content on this Site is for campaign and informational purposes only and does not constitute legal, financial, or other professional advice.

2) No Government Affiliation

Unless expressly stated, the Campaign is not affiliated with, endorsed by, or sponsored by any government agency, court, or law enforcement office.

3) Eligibility and Compliance With Law

By using the Site and submitting forms, you agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, including Virginia election and campaign-finance laws. If you submit a volunteer request or donation, you represent that you are eligible to do so under applicable law and the rules shown on the relevant form or donation page.

4) Volunteer Requests; Volunteer Forms and Communications

The Site may include forms to request volunteer help. If you submit information through volunteer forms:

- you represent it is accurate and complete;
- submitting a form does not guarantee placement, scheduling, or assignment of volunteer opportunities; and
- we may use the information you provide to contact you about volunteer opportunities.

5) Text Messaging (SMS) and Email Communications

The Site may allow you to opt in to receive campaign-related updates about events and activities by **text message (SMS)** and/or **email**.

- **Opt-in:** By providing a phone number/email and submitting a form, you may be opting in to receive messages from the Campaign.
- **Message frequency:** Frequency may vary based on your interactions and campaign activity.
- **Rates:** Standard message and data rates may apply. Message delivery is not guaranteed.
- **How to opt out (SMS):** If you receive SMS messages, you may be able to opt out by replying “STOP” (or as otherwise directed in the message). You may also request removal by contacting voterickeyrdandridgeforsheriff@gmail.com.
- **Emergency use:** Campaign messages are not monitored as an emergency service. Do not use text or email sign-ups for urgent or emergency needs.
- **Delivery failures:** We are not responsible for messages that fail to deliver due to your wireless provider, device, network, or settings.

6) Donations

If you choose to donate through the Site, contributions may be processed by a payment processor and/or handled through a donation mechanism provided by or on behalf of the Campaign.

By donating, you agree that:

- you are eligible to make the contribution under applicable law;
- you authorize the processing of your donation as described during the checkout/donation process;
- donation timing, processing, and eligibility may be subject to election timing, legal requirements, and applicable limits; and
- refunds may be limited or unavailable, to the extent permitted by law and the donation/processing platform's policies.

7) User-Submitted Content

If the Site includes fields where you may submit content (for example, messages or form entries), you agree not to submit:

- unlawful, threatening, abusive, harassing, obscene, or otherwise inappropriate content;
- content that infringes someone else's rights; or
- personal data you do not want the Campaign to use for campaign-related purposes.

We may remove or restrict submissions at our discretion.

8) Third-Party Services and Links

The Site may use or connect to third-party services (such as donation processors, SMS/email delivery services, hosting, and analytics). We do not control third-party websites or services, and we are not responsible for their content, policies, or practices, including how they handle data.

All content on the Site, including text, images, logos, and graphics ("Content"), is owned by the Campaign or used with permission and is protected by applicable copyright and trademark laws.

You may view and download Content only for your personal, non-commercial use. You may not copy, distribute, publish, or create derivative works from Content without permission, except as permitted by law.

You agree not to:

- use the Site to violate any applicable law;
- interfere with or disrupt the Site's operation or security;
- attempt unauthorized access;
- transmit malware, spam, or harmful code; or
- scrape, harvest, or collect data from the Site except where expressly permitted.
