


<u> Home Pick-Up Areas</u>

Highlights of Mid-Wales

Day 1 Home pick-up and travel to Bryngwyn Hall and gardens. A private guided tour with Lady Linlithgow and a delicious buffet lunch included here. Continue onto The Metropole Hotel for 4 nights stay.

Day 2 A scenic drive today through the black and white villages to Hampton Court Castle. This 15th Century Castle is surrounded by spectacular gardens, containing herbaceous borders, water features and fantastic views.

Day 3 Today's visit is to Aberglasney Gardens, one of Wales' finest gardens. Spend time exploring the 10 acres of magnificent planting schemes including their unique Elizabethan Cloister Garden before departing for an afternoon in Brecon.

Day 3 After a leisurely start, we will spend the day in Aberdeen. We will be joined by a guide to take us on a guided tour of the city followed by time at leisure. From here we will depart to the ferry terminal for dinner on board and overnight travel to Lerwick.

Day 4 Breakfast is on board the ferry this morning before disembarking. We will then meet our guide who will take us on a tour of the North Isles via Sullom Voe Oil Terminal to Toft. We will take the ferry to Ulsta on the Isle of Yell where we will visit Old Haa museum. This hosts a collection of historic objects and contemporary arts and crafts exhibitions. We will travel north to catch the short ferry from Gutcher to Belmont before a scenic drive north via Unst Heritage centre and Skidbladner, a viking long ship. Continue to to one of the most northern points Saxa Vord Radar Station. From here we will travel back south to Lerwick and our hotel for 2 nights stay. Lunch is included today.

Day 5 We journey south today to visit the the Shetland Croft House Museum.

Continue on to the prehistoric Norse settlement of Jarlshof, spanning over 3000 years of history and including longhouses, Iron Age broch and medieval farmhouses. After time here we visit the Shetland Croft House Museum. This is a typical thatched croft house of the 19th century fully restored with traditional materials. After a visit to Sumburgh Head, the southern most point of the Shetlands, we will return to Lerwick for free time and lunch. This afternoon we shall continue with our Shetland guide across to Scalloway to visit the Scalloway Museum and Carol's Ponies for a talk and photo opportunity.

Day 6 We explore the northern mainland today with our Shetland guide, travelling via Girlsta and Brae to the Tangwick Haa museum. Here, artefacts and photographs show different aspects of life in the North of Shetland through the years. Later, after a visit to the Shetland museum in Lerwick, we have time at leisure before we say farewell to the Shetland Isles and board our ferry back to Aberdeen for

Day 3 We begin the day with a relaxing cruise on the Kentish Lady from Maidstone. On then to the lesser-known hole Park Gardens. One of the Seven Wonders of the Weald, where four generations of the Barham family have created a wonderful 16 acre garden in a magical parkland setting.

Day 4 This morning we visit Hever Castle, the childhood home of Anne Boleyn. The splendid rooms and award-winning gardens boast over 700 years of history making this a memorable visit at any time of year. Continue to Rochester, famous for its links to Charles Dickens. Explore attractions such as Restoration House, the Guildhall Museum and the cathedral.

Day 5 Travel to Anglesey Abbey, a Jacobean-style house believed to have been originally founded by Henry I in 1135 as the hospital of St Mary. Explore the house, extensive gardens and watermill before returning to Yorkshire.



Day 1 Home pick-up and travel to Thornbridge Hall, a grade II listed stately home nestled in the heart of the peak district. We will enjoy a house tour followed by a cream tea and time in the garden.

Day 2 Begin the day in charming Chester with a tranquil, 30 minute cruise on the River Dee, including commentary. After some free time and lunch, travel north to the Wirral Peninsula and the award winning Ness Botanic Gardens. Founded in 1898 by Arthur Kilpin Bulley, a cotton merchant with a passion for gardens and plant collecting.

Day 3 Travel to Northwich for a ride on the magnificent Anderton Boat Lift. Originally built in 1875, the structure lifts passengers aboard the elegant Edwin Clark boat from the River Weaver to the Trent and Mersey Canal high above. From here we will continue on to Arley Hall and Gardens for the afternoon. Admire the historic herbaceous borders which are thought to be the earliest in the country.

Day 4 A leisurely drive travelling over the spectacular Horseshoe Pass to Llangollen. Enjoy time at leisure here before a short transfer to Froncysyllte to join a canal cruise on a brightly coloured narrowboat. You will cross the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, or 'Stream in the Sky', then through the beautiful Vale of Llangollen.



(1). A reservation is not booked until the completed booking form and deposit fee has been received by us. Deposits for UK tours are £80 per person, European tours including Ireland are £100 per person. Provisional bookings by phone or e-mail will be held for 10 days pending receipt of the booking form and deposit. Should any ticketed venue be included in the tour, the ticket cost may be payable at the time of booking, the cost will be printed on the itinerary. Upon receipt by us of your deposit, we shall send you a confirmation letter. The final balance will be due at the latest **9 weeks** before the departure date. Any bookings made after this point will be require to pay the full amount at the time of booking. Every person making a booking on behalf of a passenger or group of passengers warrants and confirms that he/she has authority of that passenger and that each such passenger agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.


