HOW TO DOWNLOAD THE D6 CONNECT APP AND REGISTER USING TOKEN?

1. Search for "d6 Connect" in Google Play Store, Apple AppStore or Huawei App Gallery.









- 2. Click on the relevant "Install" button.
- 3. Click "Open" once the application is installed.
- 4. Select "Token" and enter the token number you received in the invitation message.

The token helps you to connect to your school and child without having to enter all your personal details.

If the token expired or you are unable to retrieve the token number, follow the steps below to register manually.

NB: All learners should still bring a rim of printing paper (A4 Typek) at the beginning of the year.

ABSENTEEISM

All learners must attend classes without fail. If there is any valid reason for absenteeism, the parent must bring it forward.

THEFT

Stealing other learners' possessions is a crime and a bad personal trait. Theft of any sort, is punishable by National law, suspension and could eventually lead to expulsion.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Learners may not bring or use alcohol, cigarretes, and other drugs. They will not be allowed into the school grounds if they are found in their person or if they show any sign of intoxication. Drugs pose a threat to your mental, pyhsical and mental health.

RULES ENFORCEMENT

- Learners who behave in an unacceptable manner, that is bullying other learners and teachers, fighting, etc, will be suspended from school for a specific period of time as a correctional and control measure.
- Extreme violence and other safety threats or cases will be forwarded to the police or other governing bodies for further investigation and correction.
- If after suspension and warnings the child is still mischievous, they will be expelled permanently from the school.
- Learners who break school property take full responsibility of that mistake, which means they are to pay for what they break, with the help of their parents, without failure.

MEETINGS

Parents meetings are to be attended without failure. This is a way of communicating with our stakeholders (parents) in person. We urge all parents to take them seriously. Meeting dates and times shall be communicated in time.

LEARNERS' APPEARANCE

- All learners are encouraged to be presentable, girls are not allowed to plait long extensions, they can only plait straight back; relax their hair or natural hair.
- All learners sporting dreadlocks are encouraged to tie them neatly or plait them.
- No cutex, make up, face powders, long earrings (only studs are allowed).
- Girls must not alter their skirts into mini skirts. Skirts should only be two (2) fingers, just above the knees.
- Boys are also not allowed to alter their shool trousers into skinny or 3 quarter pants. They will only cut the length of the trousers according to their height, so that they partially cover the school shoes.
- Only the navy blue socks with red stripes will be accepted as part of the uniform, for both girls and boys.
- Beanies or wooly hats for winter must be worn properly, covering both ears and folded just once, or worn in any other presentable manner other than shaped to one side, folded too many times to cover just the top of the head or covering one eye like a thug.

NB: As a proud African school, we allow children to wear their African attire of any kind, on days where casual clothing is allowed or heritage day.

PUNCTUALITY

Learners must always try to arrive at school on time. They should learn as early as now to obey and keep time as they are being groomed for the future. The school will enforce and promote this aspect of mannerism, always.

LANGUAGE

The school is an english medium school, therefore we urge all learners within the school premises to converse in English. Vulgar or offensive language and gestures is unacceptable.

BULLYING

All learners have the right to a safe, fun and welcoming environment. Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated and could result in expultion if warnings are not effective.
