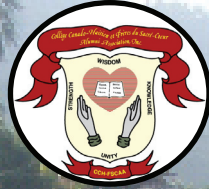

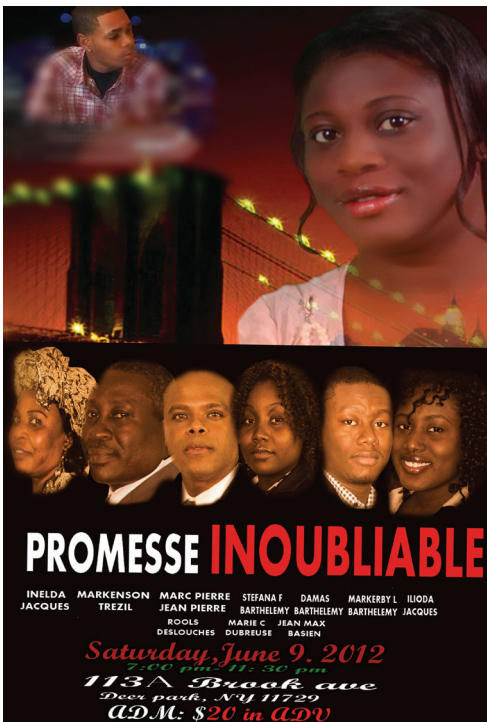

# Dr. Georges J. Casimir

Dr. Georges J. Casimir

Le Dr Georges J. Casimir a fait ses études secondaires au Collège Notre-Dame et au Lycée Philippe Guerrier du Cap-Haïtien, en Haïti. Il a obtenu la troisième meilleure note lors des examens du Bac, 2<sup>ème</sup> partie en 1969. Il est diplômé de la Faculté de Médecine et de Pharmacie de l'Université d'Etat d'Haïti en 1976. Il commença alors une carrière en psychiatrie comme un résident au Centre de psychiatrie Mars et Kline en Haïti. En 1979, il émigra aux Etats-Unis, où il compléta sa formation en psychiatrie générale et en psychiatrie gériatrique à Kingsboro Psychiatric Center and Suny Downstate Medical Center respectivement.

Dr Casimir est actuellement Professeur clinicien adjoint de psychiatrie, Directeur adjoint de la division de psychiatrie gériatrique et d'un programme de formation à Downstate Medical Center. Ses différentes accréditations dans la sphère de la psychiatrie, ses connaissances et son expérience lui ont permis d'occuper des postes administratifs et académiques aux plus hauts échelons dans diverses institutions prestigieuses, tels Kingsboro, Maimonides, Suny Downstate and Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Centers. Il est également certifié par l'American Society of Addiction Medicine et l'American Society of Clinical Psychopharmacology.

Le Dr Casimir est un enseignant chev-

ronné et a donné de nombreuses conférences dans les domaines qui relèvent de sa sous-spécialisation, y compris la santé mentale dans différentes cultures, l'appartenance ethnique et les troubles du sommeil etc... Il a été instructeur à différents programmes de formation dans la zone métropolitaine de New York. Le Dr Casimir est un ancien président de l'Association des Médecins Haïtiens à l'étranger (AMHE). Il s'intéresse beaucoup à la politique, tant en Haïti qu'aux Etats-Unis. Ses talents pour la levée des fonds sont connus, surtout au bénéfice des politiciens qui prônent des causes qui ont une incidence positive sur la communauté haïtienne. Il a également reçu plusieurs invitations à donner des conférences par l'Association Psychiatrique Américaine et par le comité sur le vieillissement de la Chambre des Représentants à Washington.

Le Dr Casimir a reçu des subventions à hauteur de huit millions de dollars pour la recherche, de nombreux organismes nationaux, comme l'Institut National de la santé mentale, etc... Il a siégé au Conseil Consultatif de plusieurs grandes sociétés pharmaceutiques, tels que Bristol Myers Squibb, Pfizer Inc., Astra Zeneca, etc...

Au cours des dix dernières années, le Dr Casimir a développé un vif intérêt

pour le domaine de la médecine du sommeil, avec un accent sur la recherche et la gestion des troubles du sommeil chez les femmes et les populations minoritaires. Il a co-écrit trois chapitres de livres et a publié trente-six articles revus par des pairs. Ses présentations cliniques et activités professionnelles ont bénéficié d'une large publicité dans des journaux comme le New York Post, le Daily News, le Miami Herald etc....


Le Dr Casimir est le plus fier de son expérience dans le domaine de l'enseignement en Haïti. Il a commencé sa carrière d'enseignant à l'âge de 18 ans, et a enseigné divers sujets comprenant le Latin, les Sciences Sociales, la Biologie et la Chimie au Collège Canado-Haïtien, le Collège Grégoire Eugène, la Faculté de Médecine etc...

Par delà toutes les réalisations susmentionnées, le fait d'avoir élevé ses enfants tout seul au cours des 11 dernières années demeure pour le Dr Casimir le travail le plus riche et le plus valorisant de toute une vie. Le Dr Casimir est un bon clinicien, un chercheur et un père de famille dévoué qui a fait sienne la déclaration de Margaret Mead: " Il suffit seulement d'un petit groupe de personnes pour changer le monde, en effet c'est la seule chose qui ait jamais réussi".

# **Dr. Georges J. Casimir**



**Dr. Georges J. Casimir**

Dr. Georges J. Casimir is a proud native of Cap-Haitien, Haiti. He grew up in that city and for his secondary cycle of studies, he attended the College Notre Dame and the Lycee Phillippe Guerrier. Later, in 1969, he crowned this effort by capturing the important recognition as third best student nationally indicated by the results from the Baccalaureate exams (Part II -- Humanities Section). Subsequently, he set out to fulfill his medical aspirations by attending the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmacy of the State University of Haiti. While engaged in the pursuit of his medical career, Dr. Casimir multitasked in other fruitful activities which included a successful period of Teaching at the Canado-Haitian College. He graduated in 1976 and, in 1977, he made his career debut in Psychiatry as a resident at the Psychiatric Center Mars & Kline (Haiti). In 1979, we find Dr. Casimir in the United States where he completed residency training in General Psychiatry and also obtained a fellowship in Geriatric Psychiatry at Kingsboro Psychiatric Center and SUNY Downstate Medical Center, respectively. In addition, Dr. Casimir is very active energizing the community, in various ways, with his extensive acquired knowledge and wisdom.

Since he's been active in his chosen career path, Dr. Casimir has diversified his career credentials in quite dynamic fashion. At

SUNY Downstate Medical Center, he is currently Clinical Associate Professor of Psychiatry, Associate Director of the Geriatric Psychiatry Division and the Geriatric Psychiatry Fellowship Training Program. He has occupied many administrative positions at Kingsboro Psychiatric Center, Maimonides Medical Center, and again SUNY Downstate Medical Center. In 2002, he was appointed Vice-President of Medical Affairs and Medical Director of Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Center, a position he held until 2004. Dr. Casimir owns a Diploma from the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology with added certifications in Geriatric Psychiatry, Addiction Psychiatry, and Forensic Psychiatry. Moreover, he is also board certified by the American Society of Addiction Medicine and the American Society of Clinical Psychopharmacology. Furthermore, in the realm of Research, he has received research and training funding for over eight million dollars from many national agencies such as the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) and the National Institute of Aging (NIA). Dr. Casimir has also served on the Advisory Board and Speakers Bureau of major pharmaceutical companies such as Bristol Myers Squibb, Pfizer Inc., Astra Zeneca and Jansen Pharmaceuticals.

An accomplished teacher, as earlier mentioned, Dr. Casimir has lectured extensively in his areas of subspecialty including Cross Cultural Mental Health, Geriatric Psychopharmacology, Ethnicity, and Sleep Disorders. He has been an instructor at different residency training programs in the New York metropolitan area (e.g. Maimonides Medical Center and Columbia Presbyterian Hospital). However, he is most proud of and very fond of the memories from his teaching experiences in high schools and universities in Haiti. At 18 years of age, he made his teaching debut and went on to dispense knowledge in subjects ranging from Latin, Social Sciences, Biology and Chemistry in institutions such as the Canado-Haitian College, the Gregoire Eugene College, the Lycee Antenor Firmin, the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmacy and the School of Engineering R. Leconte.

Dr. Casimir is a former president of the New York Chapter of the Association of Haitian Physicians Abroad (AMHE). During his tenure he founded the AMHE Political Action Committee (HAMPAC). In addition, he is very interested and active in Haitian and American politics. He is known as a prolific fundraiser for politicians who advocate for causes that positively impact the Haitian community. He has been an invited guest speaker at many conferences such as the American Psychiatric Association and the US House of Representatives Select Committee on Aging.

Over the last ten years, Dr. Casimir developed a keen interest in the field of sleep medicine with a focus on research and management of sleep disorders among women and minority populations. He has co-authored three book chapters and published thirty six peer-reviewed articles. His clinical presentations and professional activities have received wide publicity in many local and national news organizations including the New York Daily News, the New York Post, Amsterdam News, the Clinical Psychiatry News, Miami Herald, and the Boston Globe.

All in all, if you inquire from Dr. Casimir about what he believes to be his most meaningful and rewarding life's work, he'll tell you in a heartbeat that it is the direction he has provided and the values he has instilled in his children, having been a single father for the past 11 years. Leading by example, he has fostered and cultivated a standard of integrity and excellence in all of his children. Dr. Casimir is obviously a devoted father and he values the philosophy of Margaret Mead who said, "It only takes a small group of people to change the world, indeed, that's the only thing that ever has."

Therefore, the CCH-FSCAA, with immense pleasure, thanks him for his positive contribution to the lives of countless Canado-Haitian students and others and, closer to home, for having been such a sustained supporter of CCH-FSCAA.

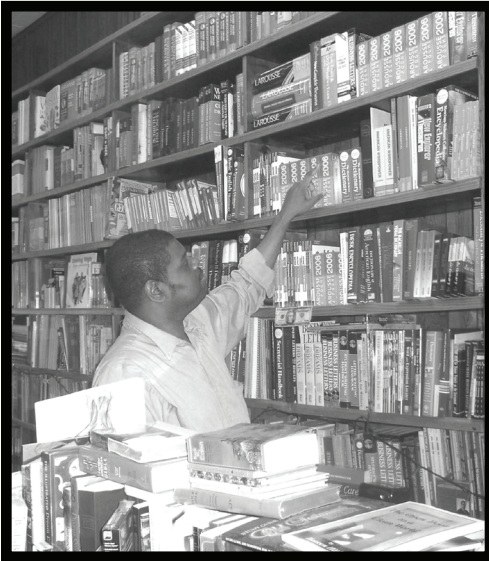

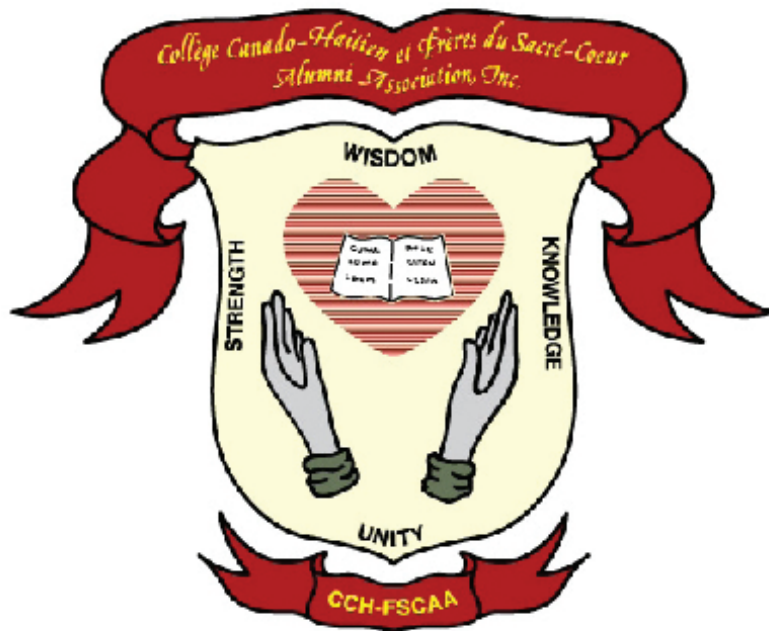
