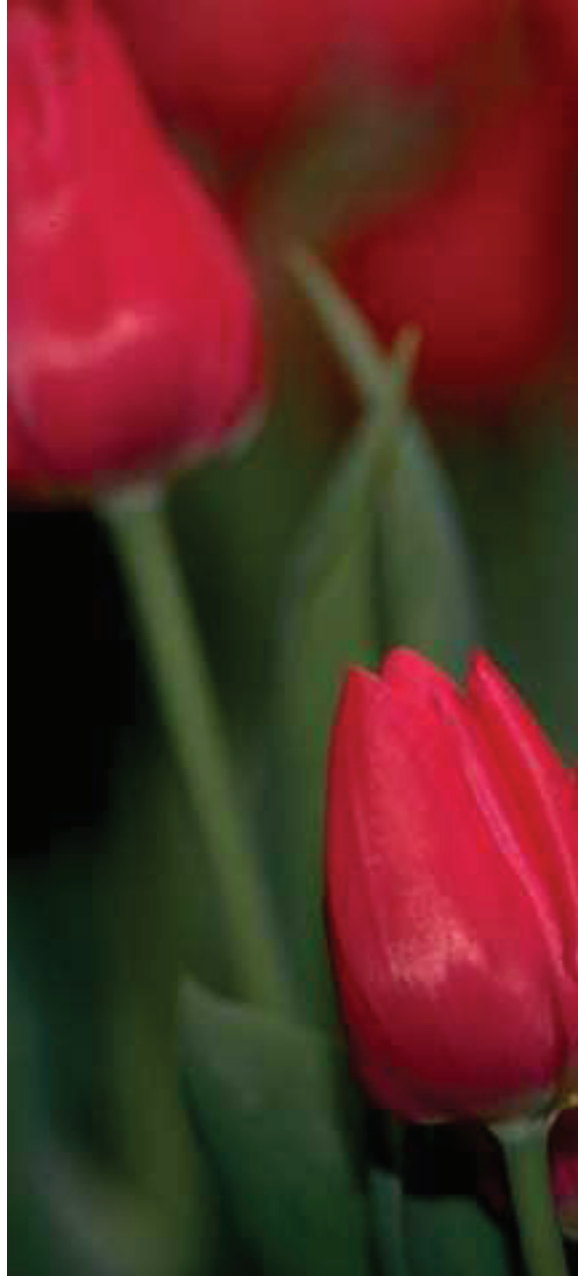

Thus, the Collège Canado-Haitien & Frères du Sacré-Coeur Alumni Association (CCH-FSCAA) was formed and legalized as a not-for-profit 501(c)3 association with full transparency and accountability to everyone. The mission was and still is to provide less fortunate Haitian students with the priceless gift of an education.

The beauty of this endeavor was not inspired as a result of a natural disaster or from a man-made catastrophe. It took root out of our loyalty to our alma mater and our mutual respect for one another. This initiative helped also to enhance our social skills, shape our minds and consciousness while deepening our love for Haiti which clearly defines who we are today.

Therefore, as we reflect back on ten years of dedication, we measure time by the hundreds of the less fortunate Haitian students we were able to help continue and finish their studies, of course, with the cooperation of the leadership of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart school network in Haiti. Dr Daniel Mathurin

Le docteur Daniel Mathurin. Il est né le 16 novembre 1951 à Port-au-Prince, Haïti. Il a fait ses études primaires chez les Frères du Sacré-Coeur du Bicentenaire, et ses études secondaires au Collège Canado-Haïtien de Turgeau. Il a été co-fondateur de l'association interphilo en 1973. En 1979, il est diplômé de la Faculté de Médecine et de Pharmacie de L'Université d'Etat d'Haïti. Il a épousé Ginette Perodin, le 21 mars 1982, et de ce mariage il a eu 6 enfants: David, Laurent Daniel, Didier, Tamara, Daniel et un fils adoptif, Manassé. En 1981, Daniel ouvre une clinique privée de médecine générale à Pétionville. Il se passionne pour la profession médicale et très tôt, il commence à offrir des soins à une clientèle croissante, le poussant à travailler plus de 12 heures par jour. Il offre des soins gratuits et de qualité aux plus démunis. Toujours animé d'un souci pédagogique, il explique pendant de longues minutes à chaque patient, les causes et les conséquences de leurs pathologies respectives.

Dès l'adolescence, Daniel manifeste une grande curiosité intellectuelle. Lecteur boulimique, il veut tout savoir sur son pays et ne se satisfait pas d'explications partielles. Il veut toujours découvrir les racines des phénomènes

observés et tout connaître de son pays, son histoire, ses écosystèmes, ses fonds marins et arrive même à questionner sa formation géologique. C'est ainsi qu'il s'est engagé dans des recherches approfondies qui lui ont permis de partager des informations peu connues. Au milieu des années 80, Daniel livre au public une abondante production scientifique, ponctuée par de nombreuses émissions radiotélévisées, des conférences et des débats. Il est le fondateur du "Haitian Indigenous Research Center". En plus de la médecine, Daniel se passionne pour la physique, la chimie, la biologie, l'astronomie, l'ésotérisme et la plongée sous-marine. Il est l'un des premiers chercheurs haïtiens à insister sur l'importance et la grande valeur des richesses que l'on peut trouver dans les eaux territoriales. Sa démarche méthodologique et ses conclusions sont d'une grande originalité et secouent plus d'un.

Avec son épouse Ginette, Daniel formait un couple qui ne cessa d'étonner par sa créativité et sa complémentarité. Ils participent à de nombreuses recherches et coordonnent avec succès de multiples travaux suscitant un intérêt national et international. Daniel et Ginette furent les premiers à alerter la population haïtienne sur les conséquences des changements climatiques sur la planète, avec des tsunamis, tremblements de terre et sur les pluies d'astéroïdes.

Voilà, en gros mes chers amis, la trajectoire de ce vir bonus, cet homme de bien, ce patriote émérite, ce médecin soucieux, ce chercheur infatigable, enfin cet être aux aspirations nobles dont le départ le 17 Février 2013 laisse dans une tristesse profonde sa femme Ginette, ses enfants, ses proches et nous autres.

Janvier dernier, si peu de temps s'est écoulé depuis, Daniel a répondu au CCH-FSCAA, acceptant notre in-

visitation pour reconnaître son travail et l'honorer durant ce gala de collecte de fonds (2013). Les deux parties attendaient avec impatience cette rencontre historique. Toutefois, ce coup du sort l'a eu où il est avec nous pas avec le corps mais en esprit, un esprit puissant qui sera éternel dans notre conscience. Toutefois, pour recevoir les honneurs en son nom, la CCH-FSCAA, apprécie sincèrement la présence de sa femme bien-aimée et collègue Ginette P. Mathurin.

Espérons que dans un avenir pas trop lointain, un autre Daniel viendra nous dire que: "L'avenir du monde est ici sur le sol haïtien.", "Le cunéiforme des Tainos est semblable à celui des remarquables civilisations mésopotamiennes et égyptiennes", "L'Atlantide est sous notre île.", "La pierre philosophale et la première bombe atomique ont été découvertes par les autochtones de Quisqueya, les peuples les plus anciens et les plus avancés en Physique quantique."

En tout cas, espérons qu'un autre viendra nous redonner cette force de croire que notre pays d'Haïti peut redevenir cette "lumière", comme Daniel l'avait préconisé avant sa mort.

Dr. Daniel Mathurin

Dr. Daniel Mathurin. He was born on November 16, 1951 in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. He received his primary education at the Brothers of the Sacred Heart school in the Bi-Centenaire district, and his secondary education at the Canado-Haitian College in Turgeau. He was co-founder of the Inter-Philo Association in 1973. In 1979, he graduated from the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmacy of Haiti University. He married Ginette Perodin on March 21, 1982, and they had 6 children: David, Laurent Daniel, Didier, Tamara, Daniel and an adopted son, Manassé. In 1981, Daniel opened a private general medicine clinic in Pétienville. He was passionate about the medical profession and very soon he began to offer medical care to a growing clientèle, pushing him to work more than 12 hours a day. He offered free, high quality care to the most deprived people. He always had a concern to educate and would spend a long time with each patient explaining the causes and consequences of their respective diseases.

From his youth, Daniel showed great intellectual curiosity. A voracious reader, he wanted to know everything about his country and was not satisfied by partial explanations. He always wanted to

discover the roots of the phenomena he observed and to know everything about his country, its history, its ecosystems, its seabed and even came to question its geological formation. This was how he came to undertake in-depth research which allowed him to share little-known information. During the 80s, Daniel published a vast amount of scientific work, punctuated by many radio and TV programs, lectures and debates. He founded the Haitian Indigenous Research Center. As much as Medicine, Daniel was passionate about Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Astronomy, Esotericism and Scuba Diving. He was one of the first Haitian researchers to insist on the importance and great value of the riches to be found in Haitian territorial waters. His methodology and conclusions were highly original and shook a number of people.

With his wife Ginette, Daniel formed a couple who never ceased to amaze by its creativity and complementarity. They took part in many research studies and successfully coordinated many projects arousing national and international interest. Daniel and Ginette were the first ones to warn the Haitian population of the consequences of climate change on the planet, with tsunamis, earthquakes and on asteroid showers.

There, my friends, is an outline of the trajectory of this good man, outstanding patriot, concerned doctor, tireless researcher, in short, this gentleman with noble aspirations whose death on February 17, 2013 has left his wife Ginette, his children, his friends and relatives and all of us with deep sadness.

Last January, such a short time ago, Daniel responded to the CCH-FSCAA, accepting our invitation to acknowledge his work and to honor him during this 2013 Fund-Raising Gala. Both parties were looking forward to this historic en-

counter. However, this twist of fate had it where he is with us not in body but in spirit, a strong spirit that will be everlasting in our consciousness. However, to receive the honors on his behalf, the CCH-FSCAA sincerely appreciates the presence of his beloved wife and colleague Ginette P. Mathurin.

Let us hope that in a not-too-distant future, another Daniel will come and tell us: "The future of the world is here on Haitian soil", "The cuneiform of the Taino people is similar to that of the remarkable Mesopotamian and Egyptian civilizations", "Atlantis is under our island", "The philosopher's stone and the first atomic bomb were discovered by the natives of Quisqueya, the most ancient peoples and the most advanced in Quantum Physics."

In any case, let us hope that another will come and give us again the strength to believe that our country of Haiti can become this "light" again, as Daniel advocated before his death.

Elle quitte le pays en 1982 pour parfaire ses études. Quelque temps après, elle épouse le Dr Daniel Bernadel, chirurgien et professeur d'anatomie, maintenant décédé. De cette union naquirent deux enfants: un fils, Dimitri qui a une maîtrise en mathématiques (le fruit ne

tombe jamais loin de l'arbre) et travaille dans l'éducation, et une fille, Sabrina, enrôlée à Villanova University.

Elle continue ses études à New York où elle obtient sa licence en Pharmacie. Elle travaille depuis 20 ans en pharmacie gériatrique, à Pharmerica. Son âme charitable la pousse à s'impliquer dans les oeuvres sociales et humanitaires. Elle est actuellement vice présidente de "Hand of God Ministries", une organisation charitable chrétienne qui travaille particulièrement à Djobel et Paloma, deux zones défavorisées dans la région de Port-au-Prince. Elle fait partie de cette organisation depuis dix ans. Elle rejoint la CCH-FSCAA il y a six ans, où elle est membre du conseil de direction et occupe actuellement la fonction de secrétaire. L'association lui doit en partie son succès. Elle est également membre du conseil de direction et conseillère de "Compassion Roads, Inc.", une organisation chrétienne dont le champ d'action est à Maniche, un faubourg des Cayes. Ils sont en train de construire une école, un centre de santé et une église dans la zone de Jacmel. Ils préparent pour Juillet une foire de santé (Health Fair) à Maniche. Toujours infatigable et dévouée, elle prête son concours et prodigue des conseils à d'autres organisations charitables à New York et en Haïti, au Centre de Sensibilisation

au Diabète à St-Marc et aussi à deux écoles en dehors de St-Marc.

Régine a "adopté" un fils en Haïti et se rend compte qu'à peu de frais annuels on peut éduquer un enfant en Haïti et lui ouvrir les portes de l'avenir (un autre de ses projets). Couramment, elle travaille sur un projet: To Empower Haitian Women (FAMM KAPAB). Elle croit fermement que l'avenir des enfants repose dans la liberté économique des femmes en Haïti (les hommes étant souvent absents du foyer). Son plus grand rêve est d'effacer les pleurs causés par la faim du visage des enfants déshérités de chez nous. Elle est toujours en quête de nouvelles idées et des moyens pour faire avancer ses projets et ceux des organisations dont elle fait partie. Toujours élégante, ses enfants l'appellent "The Mother Theresa on heels and with pearls."

Régine suit actuellement un cours d'administration pour les organisations à but non lucratif. Sans nul doute, la CCH-FSCAA compte bénéficier encore longtemps de son expertise et de son dévouement. Nous sommes fiers de saluer l'une des nôtres.

Regine Saurel Bernadel was born in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. She did her primary studies with the Sisters of La Sagesse in Pétionville and completed her secondary studies at the Canado-Haitian College. Thereafter, she entered the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmacy of Haiti, section Pharmacy. It came as no surprise to those who know her well that she excelled there and graduated at the top of her class. In 1982, she left the country in order to further her studies. Later, she married Dr. Daniel Bernadel, a surgeon and Anatomy professor, now deceased. Of this union were born two children: a son, Dimitri who has a master in Mathematics (the fruit never falls far from the tree) and works in Education, and a daughter, Sabrina who attends Villanova University.

Regine went on with her studies in New

York where she obtained her license in Pharmacy. At Pharmerica, she has worked for 20 years in Geriatric Pharmacy. Further, her charitable soul led her naturally to become involved in social and humanitarian endeavors. At present, she is Vice President of "Hand of God Ministries", a Christian charitable organization that operates primarily in Djobel and Paloma, two disadvantaged locations in the region of Port-au-Prince. She has been part of this organization for ten years. Six years ago, Regine joined the CCH-FSCAA where she is now a member of the executive committee and she also occupies the function of Secretary. The success stories related to the association are partly due to her creativity and enthusiasm. In addition, she is also a member of the executive committee and an advisor to Compassion Roads, Inc., a Christian organization whose sphere of activities covers Maniche, a suburb of Les Cayes. This organization is now undertaking the construction of a school, a health center and a church in the Jacmel region. Scheduled for July, this entity is preparing for a health fair to be taken place in Maniche. Always tireless and devoted, she helps around and provides counseling to other charitable organizations based in New York and in Haiti. These include the Center of Awareness to Diabetes in St. Marc and also to two schools outside of St. Marc.

Regine has "adopted" a son in Haiti and realized that with a limited amount of expenses, one can help educate a child in Haiti and open to him or her doors to a decent future (another one of her projects). Currently, she is working on this particular project entitled "To Empower Haitian Women" or "FAMM KAPAB." She firmly believes that the future of the children rests substantially on economical freedom for the women in Haiti (the men being often absent from the home). Her biggest dream, on behalf of the underprivileged children of our country, is to erase from their faces the tears that flow as a result of the effects of hunger. Regine always is in quest for new ideas and means to help advance her projects and those of the organizations to which she belongs. Always elegant in appearance, her children fondly refer to her as "The Mother Theresa with heels and pearls."

Regine is now attending a course in Administration geared toward the handling of non-profit organizations. It goes without saying that the CCH-FSCAA is looking forward to benefit further from her devotion and expertise. We are very proud to salute one of our own. Cheers Regine!

Dany Laferrière

Dany Laferrière, né Windsor Kléber Laferrière est un intellectuel haïtien vivant à Montréal, Canada. Il est né à Port-au-Prince le 13 avril 1953. Son écriture privilégie le style autobiographique. Il obtint le Prix Médicis 2009, l'un des trois plus prestigieux prix littéraires français pour son roman: « L'Énigme du retour ». Il a passé son enfance à Petit-Goâve avec sa grand-mère Da (personnage marquant de son œuvre). À 11 ans, il est de retour à Port-au-Prince pour ses études secondaires chez les Frères du Sacré-Cœur au Bicentenaire.

Plus tard, grâce à sa grande culture, il devient chroniqueur culturel au « Petit Samedi Soir » et « Radio-Haïti-Inter ». En 1976 à 23 ans, il s'établit à Montréal, craignant pour sa vie dans l'Haïti des Duvalier. En 1979, il passa un séjour de 6 mois à Port-au-Prince où il rencontre sa conjointe Maggie. De leur union sont issues trois filles: Melissa (née à Manhattan), Sarah et Alexandra (nées à Montréal). En Novembre 1985, il publia son premier roman « Comment faire l'amour avec un nègre sans se fatiguer ». Ce roman connaît un succès énorme et donne à Dany une visibilité immédiate; il a été adapté au cinéma en 1989.

A partir de 1990, il alla vivre à Miami avec sa famille. En 2002, il se réinstalle à Montréal. En Été 2007, il devint chro-

niqueur-éditorialiste à Radio Canada. Il se trouvait en Haïti en mission littéraire lors du tremblement de terre, le 12 Janvier 2010. Ce qui l'inspire à publier « Tout bouge autour de moi ».

Dany Laferrière

Dany Laferrière born Windsor Kléber Laferrière, is a Haitian intellectual living in Montréal, Canada. He was born in Port-au-Prince on April 13, 1953. In his writing, he prefers the autobiographical style. In 2009, he won the Medicis Prize, one of the three most prestigious French literary prizes for his novel: "The Enigma of the Return". He spent his childhood in Petit Goâve with his grandmother Da (a significant character in his work). When he reached age 11, he returned to Port-au-Prince to pursue his secondary studies attending the Brothers of the Sacred Heart school located at the Bicentenaire.

Later, thanks to his cultural versatility, he became cultural columnist for "Petit Samedi Soir" and "Radio-Haïti-Inter". In 1976, at 23 years of age, he settled in Montreal fearing for his life in the Haiti of the Duvaliers. In 1979, he stayed in Port-au-Prince for six months during which he met his spouse Maggie. From their union emerged three girls: Melissa (born in Manhattan), Sarah and Alexandra (born in Montréal). In November 1985, he published his first novel "How to make love with a black man without getting tired". This novel achieved a monumental success and afforded to Dany instant visibility which explained its adaptation to the movies in 1989.

In the year 1990, he migrated with his family to Miami, FL. Later, in 2002, he

resettled in Montréal. The Summer of 2007 found him as an editorialist of Radio Canada. On January 12, 2010 Dany was visiting Haiti in a literary mission when the earthquake struck. That event inspired him to publish "All is budging around me".

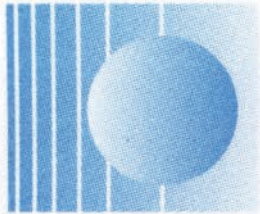

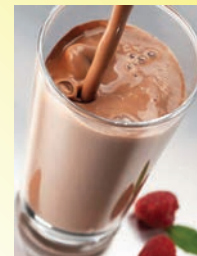

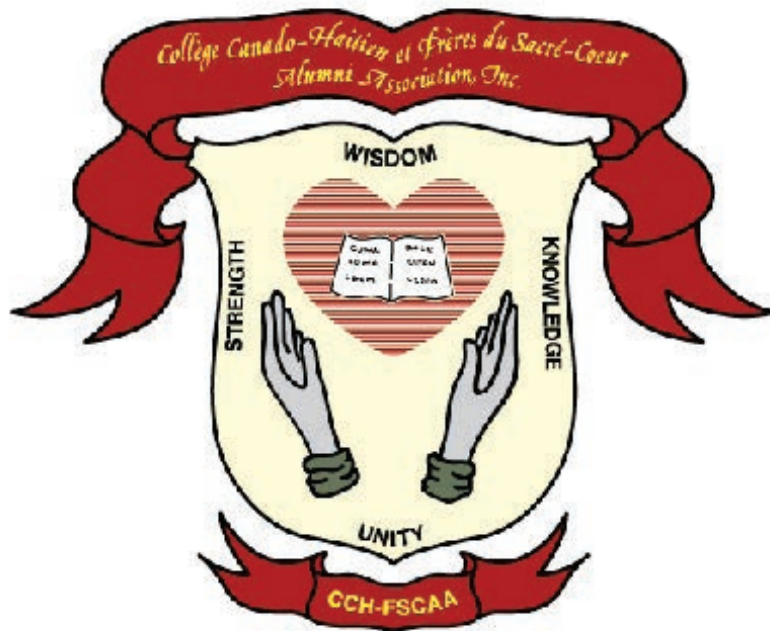
