

OUR 2023-2024 FINANCIAL REPORT

This is the time of the year when we are happy to report to you what we were able to accomplish with your generous donations.

This past year, the CCH-FSCAA came back to life, as far as resuming our traditional fundraising activities. And as usual, we were not disappointed by your response, YOU, our generous members, donors, supporters.

Right after the 2023 gala, in August, we were able to send to:

Canado Secondary School	\$3,000.00
Canado Technical School	. \$3,000.00
Juvenat School	. \$500.00
Pope Jean XXIII Primary & Secondary Schools	. \$1,000.00

For a total of \$7,500.00, as help for the 2022/2023 school year. This was money that was already marked for that year (keep in mind that back then there were no fundraising activities), but could not be sent because the Banking System in Haiti was experiencing a lot of problems.

On July 2023, we sent \$6,103.00 to Canado, as contribution for an Extra Computer Lab.

On September 2023, we sent as scholarships for the 2023/2024 School Year:		
Canado Secondary School	\$5,000.00	
Canado Technical School	\$5,000.00	
Juvenat School	\$500.00	
Jean XXIII Primary & Secondary	\$1,000.00	

For a total of \$11,500.00

On October 2023, we sent:

- \$1,500.00 to the "Nouvelle Vision" school in Laguamite, a locality outside of Hinche (Haiti)
- \$500.00 to DO-KRE-I-S, Centre de Formation Artistique, Technique et Commercial de Léogâne (Haiti)
- \$1,000.00 to "Association Monde des Petits " (AMOP), an association located in Carrefour (Haiti), and working toward the social development of the young, the adults, the teenage mothers, and especially the children.
- We also paid Lentz St Hilaire scholarship \$1,300.00

For a total of \$4,300.00

The 79/80 Promotion was raising money for a "Teachers Bathroom-Infirmary upgrade" at Canado. We donated \$585.00 toward the project on December 9, 2023.

For the second year in a row, Jean-Moise Jeanty, Class of 1982, sent us \$6,000.00 to fund the Scholarship of Excellence, in honor of his deceased young son, Kariwoyingi. The money is split into 12 half-scholarships; CCH administration agreed to put up the other half, to make it 12 full scholarships. We delivered the money to the school in January 2024.

We received from the 1970/1977 Class a check in the amount of \$8,180.00 to give Scholarships of Excellence, in honor of the late Engineer Jacques Harry Mayard. The money has been delivered to Canado.

In total, for the past year, we sent \$46,888.00 to different worthy causes. We thank you in the name of all the beneficiaries.

Years later, the same song, rebranded as "Fufu" by Carlos Santana, stole the spotlight during the halftime show of the 40th Super Bowl in Detroit, Michigan.

In resilience and dedication to community, Tabou Combo mirrors organizations like the CCH-FSCAA, demonstrating unwavering support for Haitian education initiatives at home and abroad. Led by the indomitable Roger M. Eugene, also known as Shoubou, both entities stand as pillars of strength for Haitian students and culture.

To the original members, past contributors, and newcomers of Tabou Combo, we extend our heartfelt gratitude for the profound impact they have made on the Haitian spirit. May they continue to soar on the wings of pride, serving and inspiring the Haitian community, guided by the wind of divine favor.

Berthelot Jeremie: A Multi-talented Artist

The 50th Anniversary of **Canado-Technique**

1. Context

The economy had just revived in the country. New jobs require mastery of much more technical tasks, while some companies revel in companionship. There was very little professional and technical training. The National Institute of Professional Training (INFP) and the Pilot Center for Professional Training started in the same year (1973) as Canado-Technique.

Initially, it was necessary to overcome a prejudice: some thought that "Only

individuals with low intellectual capacity chose the technique". Despite all the challenges, the Professional Training Center of Haiti (CFPH-Canado-Technique) has stood the test of time and, for fifty years, put thousands of Technicians on the job market in different fields. They dominate the economy at different levels. They effectively gain the trust of their employer to the point of becoming their partner. We take the example of Maxime Percy and Behrmann Motors; likewise, Roger Lescot and Malval Entreprises. Others have organized their own company: Mécanique de Précision by Claude Lebreton, Alaska by Roger Parisot, Chrad by Jean Lucien Ligondé.

2. Operating Strategy

The training profile is determined by market needs and new technologies. As a concrete example: the electricity course from the old program has now become Electromechanics. The qualified electromechanics installs at his client: a new building electricity system, with inverters, regulator, generator, and solar panels. From his office, the customer can start his generator using his phone.



After 14 years as a New York City ESL instructor and frustrated by the lack of resources for immigrant students, Darnell Benoit founded Flanbwayan Haitian Literacy Project in 2005. FHLC fights for change in the NYC Public School System so that newcomer youth in High School can receive the necessary support to thrive — neither defined nor limited by discrimination, isolation, or language barriers.

Dr. Patricia Nicholas, a podiatric medicine specialist with over 30 years of experience, was the first person of color and second woman to lead the New York State Podiatric Medical Association. She founded Kindest Hearts Foundation after Haiti's 2010 earthquake, establishing a school and medical clinic in Karouk. The school, now serving over 250 students from Preschool to High School, has grown from a one-room operation to a major community employer. Dr. Nicholas' dedication to education and community support has made a significant impact in the region.

She has been the organizer of the "Piquenique de l'Amitie" since 2010. It is an event that brings together the Haitian community in the Tri-State area each year at Hempstead Lake State Park in Long Island, New York. This picnic has become an event not to be missed.

Under her leadership, HAUP conducted a multi-million-dollar capital campaign with support from New York State and city governments. During the COVID-19 pandemic, HAUP provided cash assistance, resources, and education to testing and vaccination. Saint Louis founded Love and Serve Haiti Mission (LASH) in 2010, aiming to empower small communities in Haiti through education, entrepreneurship, and community service. She has held executive roles in various New York-based organizations and has been recognized for her work in publications like The New York Times.
