RANGER REPORT

We have been experiencing extremely cold temperatures the last couple weeks and have gotten about 10" of snow. Finally got to put the snow plow to use. It works great. I was able to plow the entire park and keep roads open. The side effect of plowing is the roads can be rather slick in spots especially on some of the hills. Looking forward to spring coming, nicer weather, and seeing your smiling faces again.

Clear the lines - A quick reminder to those returning to the park after a long winter, especially those in the 500's and 700's where the water was shut off for a couple of months. Please run the water at your frost free until it runs clear before hooking it up to your RV. Sediment builds up in the lines when it's been dormant over the winter. You don't want that in your RV's water system.
