## Amateur Masterclass Competition

### **Competition Description:**

The Amateur Masterclass Competition is open to all flutists over the age of 18, not currently enrolled in a college or university. Each applicant may record any solo work or movement of a solo work of their choice. Applicants will be judged based on accuracy of rhythm, intonation, and technique and overall interpretation and musicianship. There will be two winners chosen from the applicants. The winners will perform the work of their choice for Katherine Kemler, Professor of Flute at Louisiana State University, in the Amateur Masterclass, on April 4, 2020. The masterclass is open to all registered festival attendees.

**Competition Requirements** (recordings must be emailed and registration forms & payment must be postmarked by 11:59 pm on February 14th, 2020):

Record **one** work OR **one movement** of a work of your choice.

- The recording must be **unedited**. *Edited recordings will be disqualified.*
- Do not speak or make any identifying sound on your recording.
- Previous winners are eligible to participate.
- Incomplete entries will not be judged.
- All judges' decisions are final.

### **To Submit Your Recording:**

  - In the subject line of your email, enter LFS 2020 AMATEUR MASTERCLASS COMPETITION.

  - List repertoire selection.
