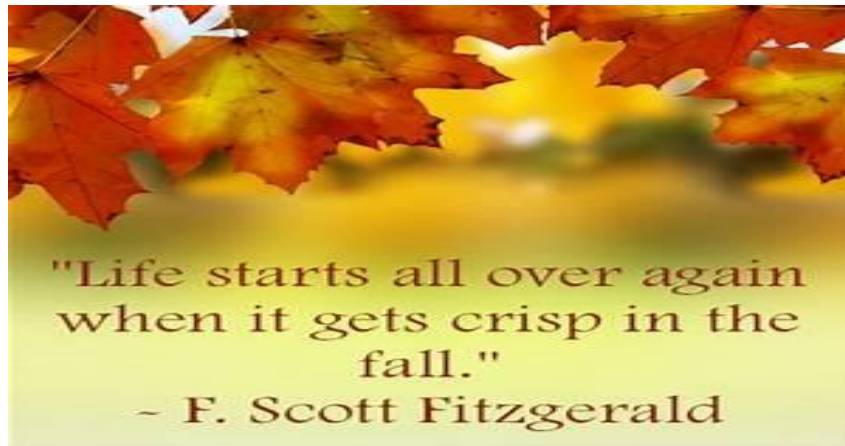




# MAPLE TERRACE TIDBITS
