Dave spent 6 years in Washington DC as a volunteer bus guide with the Honor Flight program. During that time, he had the privilege of escorting thousands of WWII and Korean War veterans through Arlington National Cemetery and answering their question about “America’s Most Sacred Grounds.” His program will include a brief history of the cemetery followed by a look at the activities that take place on a typical day at Arlington. Dave will also dispel some of the myths surrounding the tomb guards at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and describe some of the annual events that occur at the cemetery. Finally, Dave will share some of his experiences at Arlington as part of the Honor Flight and some of the other public events.
