## Resale Shopping Tips

DuPage Area Moms holds a large (nearly 200 sellers) children's clothing and toy resale twice a year at the DuPage County Fairgrounds in Wheaton, IL on the second Saturday of March and September. On that same Saturday at the fairgrounds there are 3 to 4 other not-for-profit mom's groups who also have children's clothing and toy resales. We hope that you find our shopping tips helpful. ☺

- Bring an empty laundry basket or an empty large bag to put all your treasures in while you are shopping.
- Take your purchases from the other resales to your car – **we do not allow bags from the other resales on our sale floor.**
- **Leave the children at home – we do not allow children under 13 years of age to walk on the sale floor during our Friday night presale (for our resale volunteers) or Saturday morning – this is for their safety. Infants in front carriers only will be admitted during Saturday morning.**
- Personal strollers are NOT allowed on the sale floor.
- Want to shop our presale on Friday night and beat the crowds on Saturday? Volunteer to work our resale by visiting our website [www.DupageAreaMoms.org](http://www.DupageAreaMoms.org) Resale Registration page to sign up.
- Make a list of items you are looking for to keep you on track.
- Measure your child's current clothes that fit well and bring a measuring tape so you don't buy something too small.
- Go to the "hot" items first and if they are large items that are hard to carry place them in our holding area – remember to keep your raffle ticket as proof you placed it in holding and check back every 30 minutes to say you still want the item.
- All toys, strollers, high chairs, bikes, and other large equipment are located on the left side of the building from our entrance.
- Payment methods: we accept cash, Visa\*, MasterCard\*, Discover\*, and American Express\*, and personal checks with valid government ID (aka driver's license). \*A nominal convenience fee added for all credit card transactions. Sorry we cannot split credit card transactions into difference payment types (i.e., credit card and check).
