



Car Seat & Booster Seat Information

Please Read Before Selling or Buying a Used Car Seat or Booster Seat!

We only accept car seats and booster seats that have the manufacture date sticker and an expiration date. The expiration date is either stamped into the car seat or on the manufacturer's tag. Car seats and booster seats in which the manufacturer's tag or date has been removed will not be accepted. No one will be able to tell or prove when the seat was manufactured without it. The manufacturer's tag also contains the model number of the car seat or booster seat. This important information will allow the buyer of the car seat or booster seat to check for any recalls that the seller may have missed. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) has information about whether any recalls have been issued <https://www-odi.nhtsa.dot.gov/recalls/childseat.cfm>. We suggest that all buyers of car seats or booster seats take responsibility for their purchases by visiting NHTSA website.

Also, we do not accept car seats or booster seats that have been involved in an accident. Even a small fender bender can compromise the integrity of the car seat or booster seat. We request that the sellers think of the children whose lives are at stake when selling a car seat or booster seat and not of the monetary gain. Sellers that do not know the prior history of their car seat or booster seat (bought used, was a friend's, etc.) are asked not to sell it.

Furthermore, all unsold car seats or booster seats must be picked up at the end of the sale. By federal mandate, charities are not able to accept used car seats or booster seats due to the issues raised above. Sellers that are unwilling to pick up their unsold car seat or booster seat are asked not to sell it. Please help make our sale a safe one.
