Through the end of April, ALN has already been incredibly blessed to see over 1.5 MILLION people make decisions to serve Christ with their lives. Our goal for 2023 is to see over 3.8 million make decisions. We are on target with our goal and believing God for continued strength and favor to see this goal reached.



NGOZI, BURUNDI

We completed our first two crusades in Burundi, West Africa.

Burundi is currently the least developed and poorest country in the world with a per capita income of \$292.00 US. In these two campaigns nearly 1.2 million



Burundians put their trust in Jesus! This is about 10% of the official population of the country!

Working in a place that is this poor and undeveloped proved to be full of challenges. The poverty there is so desperate that pastors and even the governor of the region are fighting to put food on their own families tables and many don't have much energy to really care for others.

We began in Ngozi and from the first night the soccer stadium we rented was packed with people pressed in so tightly that 8-9 people would share a single square meter of ground.

The people were excited and joyfully responded to the gospel. God performed many miracles and we heard testimonies from blind, deaf, mute and lame all healed in an instant by the power of God!

HEALING OF YOUNG MOTHER

One story that particularly touched my heart was told by a young mother in Ngozi. She came to the stage in tears of joy and told us this story. She had her first child but her breasts were not producing any milk. As a result, the baby died of starvation. She had a second pregnancy but miscarried.

She got pregnant a third time and the child was born premature at seven months. The hospital staff advised that the child should be fed on cows milk and if she could get it, formula. The baby was now six months old surviving only on cows milk.

When the mother came to the Crusade Ground, a Counselor encouraged her that tonight was the night of her miracle. She advised her that as the servant of God prays, the mother should hold her breasts with both hands. The counselor took care of the baby. After the prayer, the counselor handed the baby back and advised the lady to start breast-feeding. Immediately, she could feel her breasts fill with milk and for the very first time her baby began to nurse normally. When she came to give testimony she said with overwhelming joy, "My baby ate until she couldn't eat anymore!!"

The Pastor of the Mother attested to this miracle.



EVANGELISM TRAINING

From there we returned to Rwanda to spend two days with our first 20 Go-Cycle motorcycle evangelists. We brought them from Tanzania where they live and minister to our headquarters in Kigali Rwanda. Most of them had never crossed a border and they were all so excited.



Each of these men had time to share their stories and tell of some of the challenges and victories that they are having. One evangelist told a story I want to share with you. He was with a friend, another evangelist and they saw some boys that seemed distressed and anxious and nearly out of their minds being put in the back of a boda boda. This is a three wheel taxi. The men asked the driver where he was taking them. He said to the hospital. Something was terribly wrong with the kids and they didn't know what else to do. Our evangelists asked if they could pray for them before they went to the hospital. The driver agreed and in just a few minutes, the evangelists had cast demons out of these boys and they were fine and in their right minds.



This caused the driver to ask the evangelists if they would come to his village, where he is the chief elder, and minister to many other children that are suffering from the same thing. They agreed and went to that village. Once there, they realized that they were in a predominantly Muslim village and being taken to a Muslim school. There they ministered to the children and set the demon oppressed ones free.

The village council then called a meeting and asked our evangelists to come. These were mostly Muslim people. They asked our evangelists if they would be willing to come once a week to teach and minister to their children at the school. They even provided a room for them to pray and minister to the kids. Now, this Muslim village is being transformed with the Gospel!! These types of amazing things are happening with all of these men.

After two days together training and inspiring them, we took them into Kigali to see the town, take pictures and have dinner in a restaurant, something many of them have never done before. But first we took them for a cappuccino. Most didn't know what a cappuccino was but they were so excited and were thrilled to share it with them.



These men are the first fruits of a ministry that we believe will change evangelism in Africa. Just these first 20 men have won 250,000 souls in the first quarter of 2023. They are gaining in momentum, skill and passion. They are traveling to places where the Gospel hasn't yet reached. We commissioned 20 more in Gitega and Ngozi and plan to add 40 more this year!



GITEGA, BURUNDI

We headed back across the border to Gitega Burundi. To our dismay, the rainy season had begun a few weeks early and the forecast was nothing but rain.

The day our Gitega crusade was scheduled to start there was a storm that badly damaged our stage and sound equipment and threatened to shut down the crusade. We prayed earnestly and the rain slowed to a drizzle but the stage was in peril of collapsing and the sound system was very damaged.

But, with the hard work of our team and the grace of God, we managed to get some sound operating and I preached a short gospel message to the 12,000 or so that stood in the rain. Unfortunately, we were forced to cancel the music and other festivities because the stage was too dangerous to use and the sound system was needed a lot of repairs.



The next day weather was forecasted for thunderstorms to last all afternoon/evening. However, we prayed and God literally stopped the rain and pushed away the clouds. We were also able to fix the stage and enough of the equipment to carry on the crusade in normal fashion. The people showed up in mass and over the next two days more than 97,000 people made decisions to follow Jesus.



In each city we found 10 evangelists and took them onto our team and trained them. At the end of the crusade, we had a small graduation ceremony and presented each new evangelist with a motorcycle, portable sound system, video projector and screen. We now have 40 young men traveling to places not accessible by car and winning thousands of people to Jesus.



PAKISTAN

Our skype and zoom crusades in Pakistan among the brick kiln slaves has continued to bear fruit. We are seeing nearly 90% of those that we preach to trust in Jesus. We are also hearing testimonies of wonderful miracles including God opening blind eyes and causing the lame to walk! The people in Pakistan are desperate for hope and so many are turning to Jesus.

We have over 30 crusades scheduled to Pakistan in 2023, and are looking at other ways of reaching the country.



We are now planning our next two crusades, both will be in Rwanda in July.

After that we plan to return to Burundi for our final two African crusades of the year.
