
GRAND FINALE!

We just got back to our hotel from the final night of the gospel campaign in Musoma. It was spectacular! But before I tell you about tonight, I need to share a few things from last night. I'm warning you now, this might sound hard to believe but you are on this small prayer list because I know you will understand.

As I have been telling you, this area is a hotbed for the demonic. Every night when we pray for the sick, people fall to the ground and begin manifesting demons. This typically means they collapse, begin writhing and screaming and have no idea where they are. They are literally out of their minds. We take them to a special area where people cast our the demons and almost always, if the person is suffering from some sickness, as a bonus they are healed at the same time.

But last night was unique. Because there is so much witchcraft here, we felt to really go after it during the prayer time. I began by leading people in a prayer for forgiveness of people that have hurt them and then renunciation of the agreements and covenants they made with the witch doctor. The result was absolutely amazing. Hundreds of people started manifesting demons. The councilors were literally running back and forth to the prayer tent carrying people writhing and wailing. At that moment, the sky that had been clear and blue, turned dark with ominous looking clouds as powerful winds began to howl and blow things off of the stage and causing the huge speakers to swing. There was a moment that seemed like a tornado had landed.

Everyone in the huge crowd could see that we had stirred up the devil and rather than being afraid, everyone began to shout "Jesus is Lord" in unison. Two kingdoms were colliding and Jesus as always was the victor! It was so powerful and the field was filled with joy as we knew that we were breaking ancient strongholds of the devil. It was a moment that I will never forget.

Tonight was the finale. The Regional Commissioner (Governor), came and actually preached. He is a strong Christian and wanted to show his support for all we are doing here. He is prepared to go to any lengths to support us wherever we go in Tanzania.

The evening was wonderful and so many were saved, healed and delivered. The final count for the event was 413,449 people that made decisions for Christ. I am in awe of what we saw God do. We also trained thousands of believers in follow-up and thousands more in evangelism. I will be excited to share more testimonies as we begin to hear of baptisms, new churches opening and the growth of the churches here.

Thank you so much for your faithful prayers. It is the prayers that have prepared the ground for such a rich harvest of souls for Jesus. Please continue to support us as we will be back here in Tanzania in August in another remote area called Geita. To God be the glory!!!!!
