I want to thank all the members of the Budget Committee for their hard work over the two meetings we have had Nov 9th and Nov 25th hashing out the comparisons to last years budget, where spending has decreased/increased, budget categories to delete and add, and of course the projections for the new year. It was not an easy task! But sharing it with Frank, Bernie, Gail, Larry and Ann made it much less onerous!

I also respect our residents for the confidence you have displayed for our group! I fully expected these meetings to be packed, however you allowed the committee to work and develop a budget to press to the Board to cover the expected need for the next year. In these past few years of ever increasing inflation, prices for goods and services increasing ever upwards, I think most of us are just becoming numb to the idea of increasing costs. Will there be some increased costs in this year's budget, yes there are recommended increases in there, but they have been kept to the bare minimum we could recommend. Could they have been higher? Yes, but the committee looked only at what the association most probably needs to operate over the next year, not the max of what could be.

delete unnecessary categories they did just that! That comprised 75% of the budget. Twenty (20%) percent of the budget, twelve (12) categories increased and there are three (3) new categories making up the remaining five (5) percent increase.

The recommended budget will be presented to the Board for approval at its next meeting, then presented to the Association at the December Members meeting. Copies of the 2025 budget will go out to residents with the HOA Annual Dues letter.

This is possible as we have had to upgrade our website to a secure (https) server, the web server GoDaddy uses the same encryption used by banks and businesses to secure your web-based transactions.
