2023 Florida Legislative Session to Begin in March.

On March 7th another year begins for 5he Florida Legislature. You may have heard much hype in the news about laws pertaining to Disney, or bickering

back and forth about immigration and education with federal authorities. While it takes up space on the national news, and keeps our Governor's name on people's lips one way or the other, there will be legislation covered that May in a pact us more directly. Already, there is a lot of hoopla in the local news about proposed 'mobile home legislation'. However, this is relating to fl statue 723 covering rental parks. One group says legislation is protecting residents rights pertaining to price hikes, another group says it makes it easier for owners and managers to evict renters! Makes you glad you own your own home right?

Look out for more legislation as lawmakers continue to deal with the insurance crisis and storm damage costs. For instance, on little gems out of the last special session requires HOAS for to inspect and hold a substantial monetary reserve on hand for potential repairs. So far it only applies to HOA buildings for associations with 3 story or taller. But what if... in December they gave insurance companies the ability to consider the roofs over 15 years when writing insurance policies. They aren't allowed to refuse you just because of age of roof yet, they have to get inspection, check condition, might require additional rider, but what if.. these are just a couple of examples.

Got to watch these rascals! Remember, even if your primary residence is out of state these are still YOUR representatives, as you are property owners!

Mechanical Bull rides (Affordable Fun) and Axe Throwing (Molly's Hatchet).

Gasparilla Festival of the Arts, Tampa, March 4-5, 2023

This large festival offers top prize money that attracts 320+ top fine artists.

Grant Seafood Festival, Grant-Sebastian, March 4-5, 2023

The Grant Seafood Festival is put on by volunteers and has been held every year since 1966 in this sprawling riverside community between Melbourne and Sebastian.

Bike Week, Daytona Beach, March 3-12, 2023

For more than 75 years, motorcyclists have gathered in Daytona Beach for a spring fling and this year, they're expecting a half million.

The 8th Annual SunWest Crab & Shrimp Festival, Hudson, March 3-5, 2023

The Crab& Shrimp Festival returns to the beautiful sandy beaches of SunWest Park on the first weekend of March 2023! Enjoy a weekend full of live entertainment, crab races, tons of tasty seafood and vendors.

Marathon Seafood Festival, Marathon, March 11-12, 2023

The Key's most popular seafood fest is the "original" in Marathon.

Tarpon Arts Festival, Tarpon Springs, March 11-12

Area artists showcase their art in beautiful Craig Park along the bayou.

<u>Calle Ocho Festival</u>, Miami, March 12, 2023

This street festival is enormous: It attracts a million people to the largest Hispanic festival in the United States. The event stretches for 20 blocks with 10 stages and it has everything: food, music, art and a giant conga line.

Winter Park Sidewalk Art Festival, Winter Park, March 17-19, 2023

This large show annually earns top ranking among art festivals nationwide. In addition to the draw of high-quality art, it is located in a beautiful and historic community with big shade trees and activities to entertain various ages and interests.

Sunnyland Boat Festival, Tavares, March 24, 25 and 26, 2023

This antique and classic boat festival is one of the largest classic wood boat shows in the country with as many as 250 to 300 restored boats on display in the water and along one third of a mile of Lake Dora shoreline at Wooton Park in Tavares. In 2023, this is its 42nd year.

St. Augustine Lions Spring Festival, St. Augustine, March 25-26, 2023
