I recently had a question from a resident about tree removal, and I thought the response would be of interest to our residents.

Tree removal is covered in county code. Pasco County, like most counties in the US, strictly regulate the removal of trees and usually require a homeowner to replace the tree somewhere on their property with another tree.

Homeowners responsibility:

- If the tree is larger than a sapling, in Pasco that is over 5" diameter trunk, you require county approval, and permit, to remove it. Expect to pay \$30 - \$50 for the application for permit.

For Tree Removal Permit call Pasco County - Dade City (352) 521-4279

Occasionally a Utility Company may need to do work on your property and find a tree in the utility easement area, the 5 foot section around the perimeter of your property that is supposed to remain clear for utilities to access buried pipes & cables to service your home or the sub-division. In this case, the utility company is empowered to simply remove the tree and inform the homeowner. If the tree requires special pruning, or is larger than 18" diameter, they are required to inform the county and homeowner 3 days before action.

Tree removal laws & permits Pasco FL

A Tree Removal Permit is required for the removal of all trees with a trunk of five (5) inch diameter at breast height (dbh) or greater trees, except in the following circumstances:

Removal by agents of a utility for overhead and underground utility service, including distribution, collection and transmission lines, and pipelines subject to the following limitations:

- a. Pruning or trimming a tree inconsistent with the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) 300A 2001, as amended, is prohibited.
- b. Removal of trees eighteen (18) inches dbh and larger within corridors and/or easements shall require notification, prior to removal, by telephone to the County Administrator or designee and notification to the property owner and/or occupant at least three (3) business days prior to removal.
- If you do require a permit, you must submit an application which costs a \$30 \$50 processing fee depending on your block size.

The water district in Florida has posted restrictions. Please be sure to note your watering day so you don't get fined. SWFWMD has been known to ride through our park and had out tickets during restriction periods. They usually start at \$500 per infraction so be warned!

Water Conservation, Scheduling and Restrictions

We've been in a drought and the SWFWMD is ordering customers to strictly follow local irrigation rules.

Irrigation with potable, well or surface water is once per week and reclaimed up to twice per week, though once a week is encouraged. No irrigation between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Learn about the order.

Water Restrictions Using Potable Water
Watering Days and Times

2 or 3 - Tuesday

4 or 5 - Wednesday

6 or 7 - Thursday

8 or 9 - Friday

Mixed or No Address - Friday

Non-Watering Days - Saturday and Sunday

Residential Car Washing - Fountain Operation

The washing of non-business, personal vehicles (including trailers and motorhomes) shall be conducted only once per week.

Decorative water fountains and features, are not allowed unless they provide a necessary aeration and/or water quality benefit. Decorative water fountains or features using reclaimed water is allowed; however, a sign stating "using reclaimed water" must be posted next to the water fountain or feature.

Establishment of New Plant Material

- From day 1 to day 30, new plant material may be watered any day of the week.
- From day 31 to day 60, new plant material may be watered 3 days each week, according to the schedule below.
- An entire irrigation zone may be used only if the zone being watered contains 50% or more new plant material.
- Partial zones or dispersed plantings may only be watered by hose but not with automatic irrigation.
- On the day of installation, new turf or plant material may be irrigated at any time of day; however, irrigation during permitted hours is preferred.

Addresses ending in Days you may water:

1,3,5,7 or 9 Monday, Wednesday and Sunday

0,2,4,6 or 8 Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

Times you may water:

Morning Hours
12:01 am - 8 am

OR (not both)

Evening Hours 6 pm - 11:59 pm
