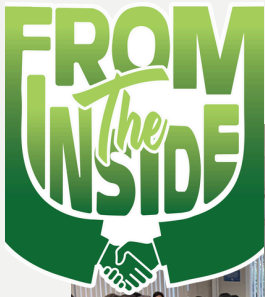
FIRST LEGO LEAGUE

COMMUNICATING WITH CONFIDENCE LEARNING LAB

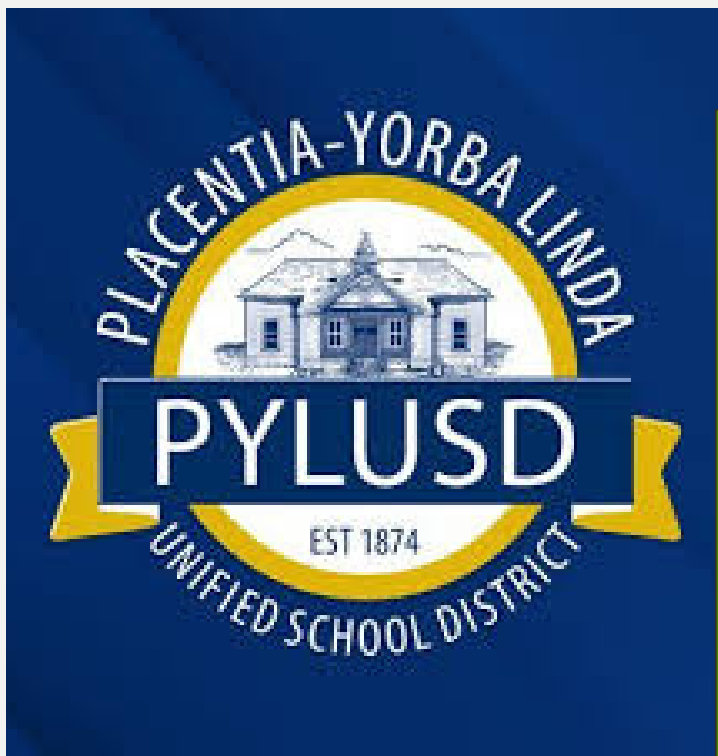
