OFFERMAN, Georgia (July 28, 2022) — The City of Offerman, Georgia, recently awarded a ‘\$15,000-Household Food Assistance Grant’ to the PIERCE COUNTY FOOD PANTRY to assist city families that have been affected by negative economic impacts because of COVID-19.



The Pierce County Food Pantry Program provides nutritious food directly to low-income families in the underserved city district that lack access to emergency food resources. This economic grant provides the funding necessary for the food bank to distribute emergency food relief safely and effectively, providing a reliable source of fresh fruits and vegetables to low-income Offerman households.
