

Getting Started with XCStats

1. How to Create an Account

Accounts in XCStats are **created by athletes** and in doing so, add their parents in the process. Here's what you'll need to register:

1. **Your schools' registration code - get this from your coach.** It allows access to the registration page.
2. Your parents email addresses.
3. Access to the athletes' email - you must to click a link in an email **within 24 hours** that comes immediately upon submitting the registration form. If you don't receive it, check your junk folder.

Assistant coaches use this same process. Athletes only need to register once in their high school career.

Athlete Registration Process

1. Go to www.xcstats.com and click on "Subscribing Schools", then your schools name. You'll see the form shown (in the upper right corner of that page). If you don't see the form, tell your coach. To start the registration process click on "CREATE ACCOUNT".

2. Enter your registration code to access the registration form.

3. You now will see the registration form! The form displays different options depending on your selections. Follow though the questions, entering the information requested, **including your parents names and email addresses**. Please note that the same email address cannot be used for both athlete and parent. If in doubt on the question "Have Results in XCStats?", enter Yes, then scan the pulldown list for your name. If not there, select No.

After submitting the form, the athlete will receive an activation email. If you don't receive it, check your junk folder. Click on the link within that email to activate your account. After the athlete activates, parents will be sent an email to activate their accounts. This email will also contain a parent password which can be changed once they login. If you have any problems ask your coach, submit them on the "contact us" form on XCStats or write us at xcsupport@xcstats.com.

2. How to Log In

Once activated, parents and athletes can login to XCStats to access additional functionality and features. You can login using a form in either of two places:

3. Additional Functionality for Registered Athletes

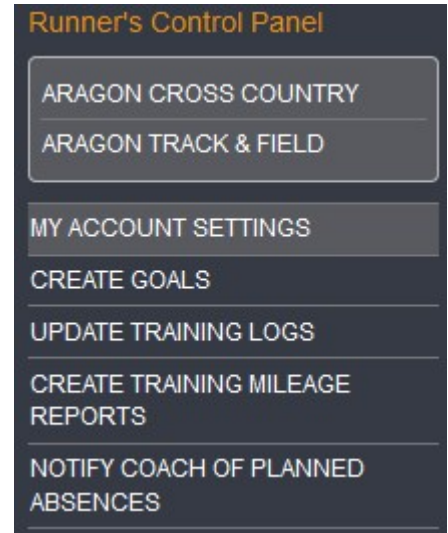
Once you login, a whole new set of features and capabilities are exposed!

From your "Runners Control Panel" you can:

- Update your account settings - add/remove parents, change email address and password
- Create goals for XC or Track & Field events, as applicable
- Enter training logs and create training log reports
- Notify your coach of planned absences.

All these functions are simple to use - just go to that page and fill in the form information.

To navigate to the public portions of the site, click on Cross Country or Track & Field links. To return to your Control Panel, click on XCStats Account & Tools



4. Additional Functionality for Registered Parents and Athletes

You schools INTERACTIVE page has many more functions for registered parents and athletes. They are

- Set your communication preferences
- Send an email to a coach
- Notify the coach of upcoming absences
- View your assigned tasks
- Enter a web link to share with the team, such as for videos, photos or articles
- Post a message to the school-only discussion forum
- Change your password (parents only, athletes see above)

To navigate to the INTERACTIVE page, go to either your Cross Country or Track & Field home pages, and then click on the INTERACTIVE menu option.
