Before you Leave Remember to...

- 1. Turn off HOT WATER circuit breaker (located in laundry area)
- Set thermostat, Auto Mode 78 summer; 62 winter Fan on AUTO
- 3. Lock all windows and doors
- 4. Turn off ice maker
- 5. Keep fans operating at low speed at all times. Circulation of air will keep your vaulted ceilings free from mold/mildew. (If you do not have a fan, you may want to consider installing one. See list of service people who do this kind of work.)
- 6. Unplug all electronic devices: TV, stereos, computers, toaster, coffee maker
- 7. Unplug all scented oil dispensers if you use them, such as Glade Plug-Ins
- 8. Leave all inside doors ajar for air circulation closets, bathrooms, etc.
- 9. Leave all commode lids in an upright position. Mold and mildew will grow when the lid is down.
- 10. Make sure all outside furniture is secured or stored, in case of hurricane
- 11. Cancel paper delivery
- 12. Fill out card to have Post Office hold mail limited to 30-day period / or Fill out card to have Post office forward mail
- 11. Leave contact information in case of an emergency or neighbor to be Contacted, and give to property manager.
- 16. Names of specific repair services to be used. Please give to property manager. (It is suggested that your AC unit is serviced twice a year. When these cottages were built, the drip lines were run into the sewer/take away lines. If these lines get clogged, major ceiling or wall damage can occur. On routine maintenance, these lines should be flushed.)
- 17. If you are renting your unit, leave the SMC Rules and Guidelines page for their edification.
- 18. Location of main water shut-off
