Dear Guests:

Welcome to the Salt Marsh Cottages! We want you to enjoy your stay and the following list of requests and rules will hopefully answer any questions you may have.

Parking

*Park in the spaces designated for your unit **only**. Each unit has two spaces allocated. If you need more space, you can park in the designated overflow parking just past the tennis courts.*

Trash/Recycling

*Keep your cottage area free of debris and trash. Trash and recycling are collected Thursday mornings. Place all trash **inside** the provided trash liners. Recycled materials include cardboard, plastic, glass, aluminum cans and newspaper. All these items can be placed together; however, they must be in a separate "recycle" container. If your trash is not collected, please call 843-368-2996 and leave a message.*

Pets

If you have a pet, remember that all of Moss Creek requests you to clean up after your pet, whether out walking or just outside your cottage. Likewise, all pets are required to be leashed at all times. There are two doggie poo stations on Devil's Elbow Lane for your convenience. These are supplied and maintained by the Salt Marsh Cottages so please use them! It is not okay to allow your dog to do his/her business around the cottage no matter how convenient it may be. Thank you for your cooperation.

Neighbors

Be courteous of your neighbors, some of whom live here year-round. Do not hang towels, beach toys, etc., outside on railings or decks. Keep bicycles in shed or out of sight whenever possible when not in use. Also, avoid unnecessary noise that may disturb neighbors, especially after dark

Security

If you have any security issues, contact the Security Office at 837-2233. Remember to have your Guest Pass on your dashboard, as they do check on parked cars.

Speed Limit

Obey all speed limits throughout Moss Creek. There are 6 entrances/exits to the Salt Marsh Cottage area, so it is very important you drive slowly and obey Stop signs. Many guests/residents enjoy walking and cycling on this lovely wooded road at various times of the day and evening. Your extra caution is greatly appreciated.
