#### Who is Advanced Manufacturing Institute San Diego (AMI-SD)?

AMI-SD is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to helping build a skilled and diverse talent pipeline that serves the region's vital advanced manufacturing sector and strengthens the broader community. AMI-SD conducts its mission by providing no-cost, tuition-free integrated job training and placement programs, technical skill development, and support services to individuals with no prior experience. Designed to address the region's growing demand for middle-skill advanced manufacturing talent by transitioning unemployed, underemployed, and low-wage workers to quality jobs as entry-level Machinists, CNC Machine Operators, Quality Control Inspectors, and Assemblers and Fabricators.

#### What is the "Manufacturing Academy" program?

This program positions adult learners with no prior experience to enter the manufacturing workforce in just 17 weeks. The curriculum combines hands-on machine training and classroom instruction in technical math, machine theory, blueprint reading, and Coordinate Measuring Machines (CMM), with special sessions focused on professional development, soft skills, and resume writing. Throughout the program, employers are introduced to participants for placement. Upon completion, graduates receive industry-recognized credentials (*Certificate of Achievement, Six Sigma Green Belt, NDT Overview Certificate*). This program has been administered to 15+ cohorts with over 150 enrollments and maintains an 85% job placement rate.

### **Program Eligibility and Requirements for Enrollment?**

AMI-SD programs are open to all individuals, subject to the following eligibility requirements:

- ❖ 18 + years old at the time of enrollment
- Be a high-school graduate or have earned a GED.
- ❖ Be a U.S. citizen
- Have internet access and an email address for application and course materials
- Having computer skills and basic mechanical aptitude

#### Physical Demands:

- ❖ Able to walk and reach with both arms and hands, and stand for extended periods
- Able to lift and carry up to 50 lbs.
- Demonstrate good eyesight, close vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
