Who is Advanced Manufacturing Institute San Diego (AMI-SD)?

AMI-SD is a 501c3 incorporated nonprofit organization established in 2014 dedicated to educating, training and connecting the next generation workforce to fill high-wage, in-demand jobs in our region. We serve the community in two ways:

- Providing advanced manufacturing job training that is accessible to everyone
- Helping address critical workforce needs with a talent pipeline of skilled and diverse workers to fill existing jobs

What is the Manufacturing Academy program?

AMI-SD's Manufacturing Academy is an intensive 17-week accelerated training program designed to provide individuals (with no prior experience) with the skills necessary for entry-level jobs with local manufacturing companies. The curriculum combines machining theory with hands-on training, culminating in industry-recognized certificates. This pre-employment program is developed in collaboration with industry partners and emphasizes technical math, machine theory, blueprint reading, and coordinate measuring machines (CMM). Career coaching, resume building, interview preparation is also included, enabling participants, many of whom face barriers, to progress smoothly along their career pathways.

- ❖ 17 weeks in length, Mondays-Fridays from 8:00 a.m. -12:00 p.m., totaling approximately 350 hours
- In-person training, combines classroom and machine shop instruction
- Training facility located at 9429 Abraham Way, Santee, CA 92071
- ❖ To date we have administered this program to 14 + cohorts, 150 + enrollments, and an 85% job placement rating

Eligibility and Requirements for Enrollment in Manufacturing Academy?

Our program is open to all individuals, subject to the following eligibility requirements:

- ❖ 18 + years old at the time of enrollment
- Be a high-school graduate or have earned a GED.
- ❖ Be a U.S. citizen
- ❖ Have internet access and an email address for application and course materials
- Have computer skills and basic mechanical aptitude

Physical Demands:

- Able to walk and reach with both arms and hands, and stand for extended periods
- Able to lift and carry up to 50 lbs.
- Demonstrate good eyesight, close vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
