Who is Advanced Manufacturing Institute San Diego (AMI-SD)?

AMI-SD is a 501c3 incorporated nonprofit organization established in 2014 with the mission to train and connect the next generation of manufacturing talent with high-wage, in-demand jobs in our region. We serve our community by providing advanced manufacturing job training that is accessible to everyone. We also help industry employers recruit and develop a steady pipeline of skilled workers for the region's manufacturers, addressing critical workforce needs.

What is the Manufacturing Academy program?

AMI-SD's Manufacturing Academy is an intensive training program that provides individuals with the skills necessary for entry-level jobs with local manufacturing companies. During the program, participants develop technical skills and expertise and earn credentials through in-class theory and hands-on labs. It is a pre-employment program developed in collaboration with industry that emphasizes technical math, machine theory, blueprint reading, and coordinate measuring machines (CMM); and includes career coaching by program staff, which enables participants, many of whom often face barriers, to progress along a career pathway smoothly.

- ✤ 17 weeks in length, Mondays-Fridays from 8:00 a.m. -12:00 p.m., totaling approximately 350 hours
- In-person training, combines classroom and machine shop instruction

Eligibility requirements to participate and get free advanced job training?

Our program is regimented, hands-on and best suited for individuals actively seeking high-wage, in-demand advanced manufacturing jobs, subject to program eligibility requirements:

- ✤ 18 + years old at the time of enrollment
- Be a high-school graduate or have earned a GED.
- Be a U.S. citizen
- Have internet access and an email address for application and course materials
- ✤ Have computer skills and basic mechanical aptitude

Physical Demands:

- Must be able to walk and reach with both arms and hands.
- Must be able to stand for extended periods.
- Must be able to carry as much as 50 lbs.
- Must have good eyesight, including close vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
