Introduction

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be aged between 13 and 22 years as of January 1 of the application year.
- Be actively involved in a community or school band, or Skunkworks Community ensemble.
- Show dedication to their musical development and a willingness to share their talents with others.

What We Look For

We value applicants who:

- Show strong musical skills or a clear commitment to improving.
- Actively participate in music activities and contribute positively to their band or community.
- Exhibit personal qualities such as leadership, kindness, teamwork, and enthusiasm for learning.
- May benefit greatly from financial or developmental support to reach the next stage of their musical journey.

What the Scholarship Can Support

- Program or event fees (e.g., camps, tours, workshops).
- Instrument purchase or hire.
- Music-related travel costs.
- Other music development expenses approved by Skunkworks Community.
