



VICTORIAN STATE YOUTH BRASS BAND – UNIFORM POLICY

1. UNIFORM

The official uniform of the Victorian State Youth Brass Band shall consist of:

- a) Uniform shirt (navy colour with VSYBB logo);
- b) Black trousers or skirt;
- c) Black shoes and socks;

2. SUPPLY OF UNIFORM

- a) Members of the band will purchase the navy uniform shirt from the VSYBB.
- b) Members shall supply their own trousers/skirt and shoes and socks.
- c) VSYBB shall issue a navy uniform cap when required (e.g., marching, outside gigs etc.).
The cap shall be returned to the property officer at the end of the gig.

3. OTHER ITEMS

Other items of clothing may be purchased from the band but will not form part of the official uniform including:

- a) VSYBB jackets (jackets may be worn as part of the uniform for cold weather events);
- b) Tour jackets;
- c) Hoodies;
- d) T-shirts etc.

4. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Under special circumstances the VSYBB will loan to members items of uniform including:

- a) Uniform shirt;
- b) VSYBB jacket;

The special circumstance may include financial difficulties, visiting or short-term members etc. All loaned items shall be returned to the property officer at the end of the event, tour, short-term membership etc.

5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

a) Property Officer –

- i. shall maintain a register of the uniform shirts, caps and jackets held by the band. The register shall record the size of the item, date of issue, who it has been issued to, and expected return date.
- ii. will report to the Skunkworks Directors from time to time on number of uniform items held, condition of uniform items and the need for replacements.

b) Skunkworks Directors –

- i. Shall consider the property officers reports and recommendations and provide funding for replacement items as appropriate.
