4. **Treasurer's Report: Samantha Pratt**
 - a. Review the month's spending - Largest revenue with the Fun Run. 2nd highest was the membership drive with \$8000. Currently have \$55000 in account. Our expenses were Block Party payback, Trunk/Treat, and teacher appreciation for the Fun Run. Net revenue is \$50,000. Down payment for shelves is \$18,000.

- b. Vice President: Valerie Decker - updating website with business sponsorships, food drive was added to homepage and every member should have received directory. Had discussed hygiene baskets for nurses and principals are donating their funds to make that happen.
Co-Vice President: Dragana Vidakovic - *Membership* - Provided prizes with membership. Collaborated with Renee to design a t-shirt. Prizes will be distributed. \$100 gift card recipient donated it back to BPC, \$150 gift card went to John Matthews and class party was Yonker's 3rd grade, who won a Ninja party on 11/16.
